The Haddon Township Education Foundation (HTEF) is pleased to announce that it is accepting applications for grants from Haddon Township staff members for classroom, grade-level or school-wide learning initiatives, projects, and/or activities that enhance the curriculum and for which there is no other funding source (i.e., above and beyond the budget).

Each of the district’s seven schools is eligible for the Fall 2020 Grant Cycle.

Each application is to be submitted to the building principal for approval. If approved at the building level, the application will be forwarded to the Superintendent for district-level approval.

All applications received by the HTEF by the deadline will be reviewed by the HTEF Allocations Committee.

Each applicant will be notified via email of the status of the application by the notification deadline.

Those applicants who are awarded grants will be notified by the district’s Business Office regarding the distribution of funds.

CONSIDERATIONS BEFORE APPLYING

Please read through these procedures and considerations before starting your application.

1. All applications must be submitted by the lead teacher to the building principal. If approved at the building level, the principal will forward the application to the Superintendent.
2. Project funds must be spent by the deadline provided. Unspent funds must be returned to the Foundation at the conclusion of the school year.

3. A final expense report and summary report about how the project helped your students must be submitted to the HTEF via email (htedfoundation@gmail.com).
4. The Haddon Township Education Foundation reserves the right to publicize all grant programs.
5. Funds cannot be used toward personal honorariums/stipends.
6. Each teacher may submit only one proposal per grant cycle as lead educator; however, a teacher is not prohibited from being a co-applicant for a proposal submitted by a larger group of teachers in the same cycle.
7. A blind review of your proposal will be conducted by the Allocations Committee appointed by the Foundation. Each application will be scored using the HTEF Scoring Rubric.
8. Items purchased with grant funds become the property of Haddon Township School District.
