Horse Powered Reading Application

Dear Friend

Thank you so much for agreeing to have your child(ren) participate in some fun Horse Powered Reading Activities! We are grateful that you have given us this opportunity. Just some quick information about horse powered reading.

Horse Powered Reading uses the Equine Assisted Growth and Learning (EAGALA) model to integrate social-emotional learning with academics. This model allows students to see and experience reading with their entire mind, body, and emotions by creating metaphors for the skills needed to read. This type of experiential learning allows the student to discover things first hand while overcoming their own challenges.

During a session the student will be asked to pick a “book” (Horse). They may choose a different “book” each session or they may get to keep working and understand the “book” better each time they come to read. The sessions are tailored to the individuals and their needs which is what makes a pre-assessment so important. This allows us to see what types of activities may benefit the child. There is no riding involved during horse powered reading. This is a place where students can learn about themselves and their “book” through the power of on ground horsemanship.

As we prepare to offer this program for our 2024 season we are very excited to see what the results will be for your child. We have many different layouts and we hope that you are excited to participate in our Horse Powered reading program. **A registration fee of \$35.00** is payable **once per calendar year**. The fee is to be submitted with the participant’s application in order to participate in lessons, and it is indicated on that form. The registration fee is used to supplement current administrative costs and program insurance.

All of us Big Maple Farm’s Natural Therapies, thank you for allowing us time to expand our learning and help us make a new program successful in our community. I look forward to hearing from you in the coming days regarding a time in which we can set up your child’s first lesson.

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Assumption of Risk, Release of Liability and Indemnification Agreement for 2024

BIG MAPLE FARM'S NATURAL THERAPIES, INC. (BMFNT) is in the business of organizing, conducting and providing horses, equipment, and facilities for equestrian activities, which activities include but are not limited to, providing open rides clinics and related equestrian training referred to herein as the "activities." The undersigned desires to participate in the activities.

NOW THEREFORE AND IN CONSIDERATION of being allowed to participate in any way in one or more of the activities as the context requires, I acknowledge, appreciate and agree that:

- 1. GENERAL.** Risks of activities include, but are not limited to, death, personal injury, loss of income or the enjoyment of life, and pain, and scarring or disfigurement. The causes of possible injury are many, including but not limited to; injury from bodily contact, incidental or inherent in the nature of the activities, slipping and falling or tripping on surfaces, regardless of physical or environmental conditions, injury from equestrian activities or horseback riding; injury due to supervision or lack of supervision by Big Maple Farm's Natural Therapies' employees or agents, including trainers or instructors, or rules or regulations and instructions (or lack thereof) regarding the use of equipment or to the nature of the activity itself, or injury caused by other participants' and malicious acts of other participants, regardless of whether Big Maple Farm's Natural Therapies had or should have had knowledge of the likelihood of malicious acts by such participant.
- 2. ASSUMPTION OF RISK.** I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL RISKS RELATED TO OR ARISING OUT OF ANY ACTIVITIES, both known and unknown, including any injury or action caused by that harms or injures in any way a pedestrian or nonparticipant, or action caused by me that harms or injures in any way a pedestrian or nonparticipant, or others, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE< GROSS NEGLIGENCE OR RECKLESS DISREGARD OF THE RELEASES (as defined in the next paragraph) or others and assume full responsibility for my participation.
- 3. RELEASES FROM LIABILITY.** I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and whomever else may have an interest either at common law or by operation of statute, HEREBY RELEASE, WAIVE, RELINQUISH, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE BMFNT, its' employees, volunteers, other participants, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises use to conduct the activities ("Releases"), FROM LIABILITY FROM ANY AND ALL CLAIMS OR LIABILITIES FOR ALL AND ANY INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH, OR LOSS OF DAMAGE TO MYSELF, ANY PERSON OR PROPERTY, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE, GROSS NEGLIGENCE OR RELECKLESS DISREGARD OF THE RELEASES OR OTHERWISE, SUSTAINED AS A RESULT OF ARISING OUT OF, OR RELATED TO ANY ACTIVITIES, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- 4. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES.** I represent and warrant I am in good physical condition and able to safely participate in any activities. I acknowledge that BMFNT has made no recommendations or determinations as to my fitness or ability to participate in any activities. I further agree that I will not participate in any activities or use any equipment unless and until I determine that I have thoroughly familiarized myself with the correct use and operation thereof.
- 5. SEVERABILITY.** I expressly agree that this agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the international laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and that if any portion thereof is invalid, it is **agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.**
- 6. MISCELLANEOUS.** This agreement is entered into Elk County, Pennsylvania and shall be constructed under the internal law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in Elk county, Pennsylvania. I HAVE READ THIS ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERM, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE, AND SIGN IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY AND INTEND TO COMPLETELY AND UNCONDITIONALLY RELEASE BIG MAPLE FARM'S NATURAL THERAPIES, INC. 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Programming Changes for Health of Horses

2022/2023 was a rough year for our horses and their health and over the last several months we have worked with other centers and looked at different ways to continue to provide quality services to participants, yet continue to care for our current horses. We ask that all participants read and understand the following changes that are being put in place. Should our horse situations change we can always revisit this policy.

Acknowledgment of reading is required by signature.

Due to the age and health of our horses, Big Maple Farm's Natural Therapies is implementing a weight limit policy. At this time participants weighing over 125 pounds are not able to ride. Big Maple Farm's Natural Therapies realizes the benefits of horses and therefore is implementing a new horsemanship on the ground program & horse powered reading where participants will be able to still have many of the benefits of horses, yet challenge the horse and participate through Liberty horse lessons. (Liberty horse lessons help the participant and the horse build a trusting relationship through connection. Horses and participants work together freely to accomplish skills such as walking, backing up, laying down, making circles, etc as a team. We will be showing some videos on our social media as examples. Be sure to stay tuned)

Participants can also work with mini horses as well instead of large horses in the liberty programming. Mini horses are able to learn to jump, liberty skills, trail courses, and more.

Please know this decision has not been made lightly, but in order to continue to provide for our aging horses and our participants in the best way we needed to visit new options. We hope that you understand and we are excited to offer this type of programming and are looking forward to all the new things many of our participants learn.

- 4:00-5:30p (Therapeutic Riding/Liberty/mini horse Lesson Times/horse powered reading)

Saturday:

- 9a-12pm (Therapeutic Riding/Liberty/mini horse Lesson Times/horse powered reading times)



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Season Schedule and Payment Options

This year Big Maple Farm's Natural Therapies, Inc. will be working in lesson groups. This type of scheduling will allow for breaks for our horses to regroup and rest as well as give our volunteers and staff a chance to catch up and prepare for the next session group.

Sessions will be grouped as follows:

Spring: April 3rd - June 15th

Summer: July 11th - August 24th

Fall: September 11th - November 2nd

These dates are subject to change based on weather but we tried to break them down as best we could into 8 Week long sessions. We are hoping we could start earlier than April 3rd but we will keep all our participants in the loop as to what we think we can do based on weather. We greatly appreciate your understanding in this matter.

Due to this new scheduling we would also like to run our payments differently. Many times we are at the arena and it's hard to remember who is paying and who is not, so things get missed. Sessions must be paid in full before they start. So if you are participating in our Spring session you must have payment by April 1st. Payment will depend on the length of lesson and type of lesson. If this is an issue due to financial concerns please reach out to Amanda as Scholarship opportunities are available.

Cost of lessons for the 2024 season will be as follows for all lesson types as they are all therapeutic in nature (Mini horse, liberty, or therapeutic riding):

½ hour = \$30

1 hour = \$40

Books in the barn = \$5

Horsepowered Reading = \$40 for the hour (only hour sessions)

We know that weather is going to be a factor as it always is, we continue to pray that someday we have a solution to where we won't have to worry about weather and services can always be provided consistently. In time things will happen but we are thankful that you are here ready to enhance your quality of life through positive interactions with equines.



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BARN RULES

1. Come into the session with a positive attitude and always remember to use a calm voice while around the animals!
2. Please be sure you have the proper foot ware! Hard soles are a must!
3. EVERYONE!!!!!! Must wear a helmet while mounted on a horse.
4. Check the Bulletin board to see your assigned horse and volunteers.
5. Be Alert
6. Be relaxed
7. Do not enter the stalls without a volunteer.
8. Always wait for assistance.
9. Be sure to ask questions.
10. Do not bring the horse into the lesson area until the lesson ahead of you is complete.
11. Enjoy yourself and build a connection with the horse.
12. At the end of the lesson be sure to reward the horse with their treat from the buckets not your hands!!!!
