ETHICAL/LEGAL CONCERNS

ASCA Ethical Codes and ACA Code of Ethics

Inform students of the limits to confidentiality, their rights as a student, and their parents' rights Remember that our ethical duty is to the student and their safety Involve the student in the decision-making process before you decide whether or not to disclose Avoid imposing your own beliefs or attitudes about the situation If you believe the student is at risk of serious and forseeable harm, inform parents/guardians California Law regarding adolescent pregnancy and health services

BEST COURSE OF ACTION

- Encourage the student to tell their parents about the pregnancy
 - Explain how their parents can be a source of support
 - Offer to role play with student (this may reduce fear/anxiety)
- Educate the student on all possible options (including abortion, adoption, and keeping the child)
 - Educate student on their legal rights
 - Provide information and resources on all options
- Reassure the student that you will continue to support them and act as a resource regardless of their decision
