Please note: The Final Assessment Fee is the fee paid to the awarding organisation and assessor. There is no exam in any of these courses – your coursework assignments are all submitted together for external marking.

Bursary Requirements

- **Level 3:** For learners aged 15+ with annual household income under £25,000.
- **Level 4 and Level 6:** For individuals aged 18+ with annual income below £15,000.

Bolt On's

At Level 4 or Level 6, you can choose to add a bolt on where you can focus on one or more I-PATH syllabuses such as Ballet, Singing, or Acting. Each bolt-on (for example, Ballet) costs **£300**. This includes access to all CPD webinars for every grade in that syllabus. When you complete a bolt-on, you'll receive an additional qualification certificate for that subject. You'll also become an **I-PATH Associate Teacher** in each area you choose to specialise in. You will still gain your main **Level 4 or Level 6 Ofqual-regulated teaching qualification** alongside any bolt-ons you complete.
