

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-9

Declaring the necessity of an election on the question of approving an amendment of Section 10 of Ordinance No. 2009-8 of the Village of South Charleston, Ohio; providing for the continuation and renewal of an existing tax on earned income of one quarter of one percent (0.25%); and providing the effective date for said proposed Ordinance.

WHEREAS, the electors of the Village of South Charleston approved an additional one quarter of one percent (0.25%) municipal income tax for street purposes at the November 7, 2017 General Election; and

WHEREAS, such tax is scheduled to expire on December 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Village Commission has determined that it is necessary to continue funding for the care, supervision and control of the public highways, streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, public grounds, bridges, aqueducts and viaducts within the Village; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 718.04(C)(2), the Village Commission desires to submit to the electors the question of continuing such income tax for an additional term;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Commission of the Village of South Charleston, Ohio:

Section 1. That this Village Commission hereby authorizes and directs the submission to the electors of the Village of South Charleston, Ohio, at the General Election to be held on November 3, 2026, on the question of approving the amendment of Section 10 of Ordinance No. 2009-8 of the Village of South Charleston, Ohio; providing for the continuation and renewal of an existing one quarter of one percent (0.25%) tax on income currently levied; restricting the use of such tax; and providing the effective date for said proposed Ordinance.

Section 2. That said proposed ordinance to be submitted to the electors of the Village for their approval shall be as follows:

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 2026-9

Amending Section 10 of Ordinance No. 2009-8 of the Village of South Charleston, Ohio, providing for the continuation and renewal of an existing tax on earned income of one quarter of one percent (0.25%), providing for the uses of said tax, restricting the use of the one quarter of one percent (0.25%) tax levied, and providing for the effective date thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Commission of the Village of South Charleston, Ohio:

Section 1. That Section 10 of Ordinance No. 2009-8 of the Village of South Charleston, Ohio, is hereby amended by the enactment of new Section 10(B)(3), which shall read as follows:

Section 10(B)(3) RATE AND PURPOSE.

In addition to the tax provided for under Section 1(B)(1), which is levied at a rate of one percent (1%), a continuation tax at the rate of one quarter of one percent (0.25%) shall be imposed on and after January 1, 2027, and ending December 31, 2035. Such tax shall be levied on salaries, wages, commissions and other compensation and on net profits, as hereinafter provided, enforced and collected in the same manner as the tax provided for in Ordinance No. 2009-8 Section 10.

The proceeds of such tax shall be used for the care, supervision, and control of the public highways, streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, public grounds, bridges, aqueducts and viaducts within the Village and the proceeds shall be placed in the Village Street Fund No. 2011, and, as appropriated from time to time, shall be used for, and only for, the care, supervision and control of the said public highways, streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, public grounds, bridges, aqueducts and viaducts within the Village.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time permitted by law following approval by the electors of the Village of South Charleston, provided that the tax imposed herein shall commence on January 1, 2027.

Section 3. The Clerk of the Village Commission is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this Resolution and the proposed Ordinance to the Clark County Board of Elections and to take all actions necessary for submission of the question to the electors of the Village of South Charleston at the General Election to be held on November 3, 2026.

Section 4. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the timely submission of the income tax question, which directly impacts public health and safety of street and other public ground repair and maintenance, to the electors of the Village of South Charleston and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
