WINTER WEATHER REMINDERS! -



No one knows what the weather will be in the coming but our Village months, Maintenance Crew is prepared to keep our streets clear of snow and ice. We appreciate your patience and caution around the plow trucks and tractors. Remember to blow or

shovel your driveways and sidewalks into the yard and not into the roadways. This causes further hazards for motorists.

Ordinance 76.14 STREET PARKING AND SNOW REMOVAL.

- (A) A snowfall emergency shall be deemed to exist when such snowfall exceeds two inches on a primary thoroughfare.
- (B) Between 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. during a snowfall emergency, vehicles shall be parked only on evennumbered sides of streets on those nights with an even calendar date, and on odd-numbered sides of streets on those nights with an odd numbered calendar date.

Don't forget with winter coming that sidewalks must be shoveled in a timely manner. This ensures the safety of our students walking to and from school as well as other community members. As per ordinance code 91.27(b) It is the duty of the property owner to clear sidewalks by 10am after snow or ice has fallen.

Greenlawn Cemetery

Spring clean-up occurs after March 15
During spring and fall clean-up,
anything resting or sitting directly on
the stone or monument will not be
removed. Everything on the ground
around the grave will be removed.
Decorations placed on graves during
Holidays will be removed 7 days after

the actual Holiday. Each time decorations are removed, they will be held for 10 working days to be claimed. After that time they will be disposed of.

No items such as shells, rocks, mulch, decorative stone, toys, glassware, wire, or similar items should ever be left on or around a grave. No trees, flowers, shrubs, or plantings of any kind may be planted on or around any grave, lot or elsewhere in the cemetery, except by employees of the Village of South Charleston. Borders/fencing, and shepherd hooks are not allowed.

We discourage visitors from putting anything of sentimental and expensive value on the gravesite due to vandalism or theft. The Village of South Charleston shall not be responsible for items which may become lost, stolen or damaged.

Cemetery Rules are posted at entrance center and back of cemetery for future reference. All rules are in place for safety, fairness and aesthetics for Greenlawn Cemetery, employees, residents and visitors.
