All exhibits to abide to the conditions of entry of the Manilla Show Society & Tamworth Poultry Club Inc.

1. The committee reserve the rights to refuse entries from any yard believed to be vermin or disease infected
2. Stewards will personally hand deliver ribbons and prizes. The Association is not responsible for ribbons that are lost or stolen
3. Breeding Pairs are not eligible for major awards
4. All care but no responsibility for any loss or damage of exhibits
5. At no time are birds to be handled other than the judge or chief steward
6. All birds must be bona fide property of the exhibiter, including juniors
7. Juniors must be 16 years and under
8. Chief steward must be notified of any or all sales and must be kept clear at all times
9. The aisles are kept clear for the judge at all times
10. Any exhibitors making remarks within the hearing of the judge will be removed
11. The Manilla show society and Tamworth Poultry Club reserve the rights to refuse entry of admission
