POSITION SUMMARY

The Broward Center for the Performing Arts in Ft. Lauderdale, Florida is seeking an experienced Head Wardrobe for the 2,690-seat Au-Rene Theater. This venue is a fast-paced venue hosting a variety of events throughout the year including 8-Broadway shows, ballets, operas, concerts, comedians, graduations, symphonies, galas, receptions, and other shows varying in size and scale. The Head Wardrobe oversees all activities on stage for productions/maintenance while working alongside BCPA Production Management, Stagehands, and traveling production personnel regarding wardrobe, and any other changes that may arise. This position is a Union House crew position and will not be a direct, benefits eligible employee of the Broward Center.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Must know how to sew both by hand & machine.
- Working knowledge of costume construction and maintenance.
- Assist with show wardrobe needs during load-in, show, and load-out.
- May be asked to assist with dressing and quick changes.
- Maintain house inventory, including washers, dryers, steamers, irons, etc.
- Maintain a clean and safe workspace.
- May be asked to assist with additional tasks outside of the wardrobe department.
- Must have knowledge of best practices and safe working procedures to promote/cultivate a safe work environment to ensure a positive experience for all artists, clients, and staff.
- Per CBA, position is not departmentalized (experience in other departments is not a required).
- Being able to work a flexible schedule including long days/nights, weekends, and holidays is required.
- Must be able to supervise large union crews.
- Be able to effectively multitask, set/shift priorities, and adapt to last-minute changes.
- A proactive approach to problem-solving with strong decision-making skills and a willingness to mentor/educate members of their team.
- Ability to lift up to 50lbs, crouch, twist, bend, stoop, climb stairs and ladders, stand and sit for extended periods of time, reach above/below neck level, and work at heights above the floor.

DESIRED EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

- 10yrs professional theatrical wardrobe experience, including experience as a head or assistant head.
- Experience in the areas of theatrical hair, wigs and make-up is preferred.
- Union membership is not required to apply; however, it is required upon acceptance of the position.
