Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all English Setters fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP). Dogs with a PAL/ILP number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

MOVE UPS (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)

Move ups for Trial #1 must be submitted to the secretary by 6:00 pm on October 26th. Because we are running two trials in one day, move-ups from Trial #1 to Trial #2 **WILL BE ALLOWED**; BUT must be turned into the Trial Secretary as soon as possible and no later than 20 minutes before the start of Trial #2.

****Please note:** If you enter a trial after October 26th and earn a title, you will NOT be able to move up for Trial #1.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering their dogs in the proper height divisions as follows:

AKC Jump Height Cards

All dogs competing in agility must **possess** an official AKC Jump Height Card. **You are not required to show your height card or send a copy with your entry. You are required to mark on your entry form if your dog needs to be measured.** For more information, please visit http://www.akc.org/events/agility/jump_height_card.cfm

Measurement/VMO

Judge Randy Capsel is a VMO. If your dog is under 2 yrs old and has never been measured by a VMO; or if your dog is over 2 yrs. old and you do not have two official (VMO) measurements, you will need to have your dog measured. If your dog needs to be measured, please arrive early to allow time to get that taken care of **before your first run.**

Change of Entry

As described in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. In addition, if notification has been received in writing from the AKC after closing that a dog is not eligible for a class entered, the dog may be moved to the correct class. The request for the move must be made at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary with the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

Volunteers

Volunteers will be needed for each class. A sign-up sheet will be available on the day of the trials.

Trial Information

The Event Center is available for move-in and set-up the afternoon of Sunday, Nov. 1st. There will be an agility fun match in the ring on Sunday evening; watch for announcements as to time.

Trial hours are 8:00 am to 30 minutes after completion.

Ring size: 90' x 110'.

Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

The building is climate-controlled. There is plenty of close parking and crate space.

Please bring chairs, crates and water for your dogs, and clean up supplies.

All crates must be on matting, tarps, plastic, etc.

No strollers or playpens will be allowed in the building.

NO SMOKING or VAPING is allowed in the building.

Dogs may not be left in the building overnight.

No outside food or beverages (including alcohol) may be brought into the Event Center.

No spectators or dogs are allowed on the second floor of the Purina Event Center.

No firearms are allowed on Purina property.

Purina Event Center – Guest Rules

All exhibitors must comply with the Purina Guest Rules. A copy of the Guest Rules is available at <https://gameonk9events.com/agility> on the ESAA page.

Important Information for Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

The English Setter Association of America, Inc. may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

REFUNDS A complete refund will be given, for any reason, if request is received by the trial secretary before the closing date and time. After closing, a refund of entry fees less \$5/run will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that prior written notification from the exhibitor is provided to the Trial Secretary.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committees, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. The English Setter Association of America, Inc., has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must enter their JH# and complete back of form. Include only AKC titles on entries.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, regardless of whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$20 returned check fee.

No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$10.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

The English Setter Association of America, Inc, its Board and Members, and Nestlé Purina Farms and its employees will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event.

The English Setter Association of America, Inc. does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Purina Event Center is open from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm.

All buildings are NON-SMOKING. Smoking is permitted outside in designated areas.

Dogs cannot be left in the Purina Event Center or the outdoor grooming tent overnight.

All crates must be marked with a contact name and phone number.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial

Weekend - Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A **separate entry form must be submitted** when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

For Exhibition Only (FEO) – IS being offered in all classes at this trial

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler may declare the day of the show
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. **Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.**
- Toys, but not bird wings, are allowed in the ring.
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand.
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used.
- Food/Treats and/or treat dispensing toys are not allowed in the ring.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO to the judge in the ring prior to leading out.
- Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier & ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations. **Exhibitors must exit the ring when the horn sounds.** FEO runs will be scored as 'absent' in catalog and results.

Ribbons and Awards for both Trial #1 and Trial #2

Rosettes will be awarded First Place through Fourth Place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement rosettes. Qualifying scores are required for awards.

1 st place	Blue
2 nd place.....	Red
3 rd place	Yellow
4 th place	White
Qualifying.....	Green

High in Trial and Reserve High In Trial

HIT/RHIT Awards: Awarded to the English Setter earning a double Q in Standard and Jumpers With Weaves (regardless of class) with the highest combined score. In the case of a tie, the English Setter with the highest YPS from Standard will be the winner.

If there is no Double Q, the English Setter with the highest score from Standard will earn the award. In case of a tie, the English Setter with the highest YPS from Standard will be the winner. If no qualifiers from Standard, then the highest scoring JWW will win the award. The second highest combined score or YPS will be awarded RHIT.

****All awards must be claimed at the show. No awards will be mailed.**

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
