### Random Draw

A limited number of spaces will be set aside for workers by the Event Committee. If you would like to be considered for the workers' draw, you must check the WORKER box on the entry form (or write it in if using a different form). ALL entries in the same envelope must be worker entries. Those entering online can email the trial secretary directly.

### Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration. Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may compete.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

### Prizes and Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to First Place through Fourth Place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement Rosettes.

1 <sup>st</sup> Place	Blue
2 <sup>nd</sup> Place	Red
3 <sup>rd</sup> Place	Yellow
4 <sup>th</sup> Place	White
Qualifying	Green

An AGCH rosette will be awarded to any dog finishing an AGCH title at these trials. A MACH rosette and bar will be awarded to an dog finishing a MACH at these trials. A PACH rosette and bar will be awarded to any dog finishing a PACH at these trials. A New Title rosette will be awarded to any dog finishing a title at these trials. Dogs qualifying in both Master Standard and Master JWW at the same trial will receive a "Double – Q" award (value less than \$1.00)

## Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering their dogs in the proper height divisions. Judge reserves the right to measure dogs entered in the trial. Height divisions are as follows:

## Height Divisions

All dogs competing in agility must **possess** an official AKC Jump Height Card. **You are not required to show your height card or send a copy with your entry. ## Move-ups

**For the Friday trial: MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CST, Monday, June 28.** Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent.

For the Saturday and Sunday trials: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Friday and Saturday respectively and must be submitted at the trial.

**Mailed/emailed moveups close at 6:00 pm CST, Monday, June 28.**

## Change of Entry

As described in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. In addition, if notification has been received in writing from the AKC after closing that a dog is not eligible for a class entered, the dog may be moved to the correct class. The request for the move must be made at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

## "After Closing" Wait List

A waiting list (30 run maximum each day) will be maintained for these trials once they have closed on June 16. The waiting list will be active until its deadline – **Monday, June 28 at 6:00 pm CT.** Any runs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. **If a run is pulled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the runs.** Entry fees for dogs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full.

## Trial Information

Setup time on Thursday will be announced after closing. Trial hours are 7:00 am to 30 minutes after completion. Ring size: 85' x 105'.

Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

The building is climate controlled. There is plenty of close parking and crate space. Please bring chairs and crates.

NO SMOKING or VAPING is allowed in the building. Dogs may not be left in the building overnight.

No outside food or beverages (including alcohol) may be brought into the Event Center.

## Changes Effective January 1, 2020.

### **Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend**

Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

## Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle and then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

## For Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO is not offered at this trial.

## Volunteer Workers

Volunteers will be needed for the smooth running of this trial. If you wish to be considered for inclusion in the Worker Draw, CHECK THE BOX ON THE ENTRY FORM, or if entering online, email the trial secretary. All entries in one envelope must be worker entries for those handlers to be considered in the draw. Volunteers will receive raffle tickets.

## Coronavirus Information and Guidelines

Masks (which you must provide) will be required at all times while in the building; including while you are running your dog.

Please remember to practice social distancing (at least SIX feet).

Exhibitors will be required to check in with Purina Security for a temperature check before entering the grounds.

This event is open to EXHIBITORS ONLY. Purina Security will be checking names at the gate.

The Purina Event Center may revise these guidelines at any time. MRKC and all exhibitors must abide by the Event Center' guidelines in effect during this event.

## **Notice to Exhibitors**

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee or the judge.

Missouri Rhineland Kennel Club may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the Event Committee.

Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in this trial the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for this reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked before the trial commences.

The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day for injured or ill dogs. Written request for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first trial day and a veterinarian's letter must be provided within one week of the trial.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Capitol Canine Training Club has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required. Failure to be at ring gate could result in the exhibitor being marked absent.

Entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must enter their JH# and complete back of form. Include only AKC titles on form.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$ 25 returned check fee.

No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$12.

No checks will be returned if an entry is cancelled. Checks will be shredded.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so, may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. This includes hotels as well as show site.

All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested with Missouri Rhineland Kennel Club, or persons to whom the assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. Photographs and/or video recordings taken for any reason other than personal use are strictly prohibited.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.

No Solicitation permitted on the trial site.

Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

No un-entered dogs are permitted within 30' of the ring barriers.

No laser pointer devices allowed in the show site building.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
