Crating

There will be **ASSIGNED CRATING** for this trial. PLEASE NOTE: You MUST fit all crates, chairs, etc. into your assigned space; **chairs must not be in the aisle**. Please do not put mats under your crate and / or chairs. Unentered dogs WILL NOT be assigned a space. If you bring unentered dogs, they MUST fit into your assigned space – be prepared to stack crates.

Class Run Order

Friday: Nov JWW, Open JWW, FAST, Nov STD, Open STD, M/Ex STD, M/Ex JWW, Premier JWW
Saturday: M/Ex JWW, Premier STD, M/Ex STD, Open STD, Nov STD, T2B, Open JWW, Nov JWW
Sunday: Premier JWW, M/Ex JWW, M/Ex STD, Open, STD, Nov STD, FAST, Open JWW, Nov JWW

Jump Order

Small to Tall except as noted below for FAST and M/Ex classes.

Walk Groups

M/Ex Std & JWW: 4, 8, 12, 24 walk and run
20 walk and run
16 walk run

FAST: will walk all classes together by jump height as follows:
4, 8, 12, 16 will walk; 20, 24 will walk - Everyone Run

*FAST will RUN Novice/Open by height - tall to small; M/X by height - small to tall

Measuring/VMO

Michele Fletcher (judge) is a VMO and will be measuring dogs at this trial. If your dog needs to be measured, please allow time to have that taken care of before your first run of the day. If your dog is under 2 yrs. old and has never been measured, or if your dog is over 2 yrs. old and you do not have 2 official measurements, you will need to have your dog measured.
