entire time? Is it the kind of place you can relax? Don't overthink it if you can't figure it out you could go again. I've noticed typically typically my second time going somewhere I've been can either be really awesome and they gain a loyal customer or awful and I never return. Now there are times where this could happen weeks or months down the line but sometimes if you post pictures or someone who knows your ex sees you. In reality there's a difference between a customer/fellow patron treating you horribly and a owner or employee treating you horribly a huge difference. Sometimes it's a one time occurrence and they won't come back. Then other times the next time you go his friend has a job there (making your experience miserable) in which I highly suggest taking your business elsewhere.



Sometimes you will experience your ex and his gang stalking buddies giving up. Be careful that they aren't wanting you to have your guard down so they can attack you in peace. Some people have lives to live and enjoy and are not about to stalk you forever. Some are indeed miserable lonely and bored they thrive off the gang stalking meetings they get a rush following strangers around in stores they get a buzz off gaslighting those who call them out. Misery loves company so be on alert for nonsense from people like that.

I understand if at this point you aren't close to family or friends maybe you don't have any or they were part of the mob coming against you... you can always make new

friends and God will bless you with a new family sooner than you think.

If God is moving you I encourage you to be prepared. Unfortunately during this process you may have to deal with gang stalkers finding you and following you around the store typically they want to scare you and make you become paranoid and confused. Why you ask then you'll forget what you came to the store for. Solve this problem by making a list that way you won't be distracted. It's not a be mean to everyone situation it's a casually preparing for my next level while being alert so I don't become a casualty situation. If you know God is moving you to a different city or state or country do not I repeat do not buy a bunch of things you can't take with you. Sometimes we be stressed about not having money for stuff we don't even need.
