Dear Neighbors:

The RPCIA has had issues with service from Waste Management. In a Special Called Meeting, the Board voted to change trash service to Texas Pride. This has not been easy, but we feel it is a positive move. We believe that WM will be picking up cans today, but we have not been able to confirm this.

Texas Pride will be delivering your cans Friday and Saturday of this week. **Our new service days will be Wednesday and Saturdays.** Texas Pride will service the community starting Saturday, December 2, 2023. Please place trash bags or personal trash cans out for Texas Pride to pick up. If you have not received their container prior to Texas Pride arriving to service on Saturday. The Texas Pride team will pick up whatever is out if it is bagged, boxed up, bundled or placed in a personal container.

The following is your Service & Collection Guidelines:

Service Days and Hours:

Trash: Wednesday & Saturday Please have waste ready by 6:00 a.m.

Containers:

Each household will be provided with one 96-gallon trash cart. Overflow can be placed out beside the cart in personal cans or bags. Cans should be between 20 and 96-gallons and under 50 pounds. Bags should also be under 50 pounds.

Household Trash:

Waste should be placed curbside and clearly accessible to crews. Waste should be in the provided cart, trash cans, or garbage bags.

Yard Waste:

Yard waste should be bagged or placed in cans not exceeding 50 pounds. Bagged yard waste should be placed curbside. Branches should be placed by garbage in bundles measuring no more than 4' x 4' x 4' and under 50 pounds. Limit 8 bundles per service day.

Heavy Trash & Bulk Waste:

Up to two heavy trash/bulk items per service day. Items include furniture, appliances, carpeting (tied and bundled), fencing (nails removed, tied and bundled under 4' in length), and other items not disposed of regularly. Items should be by garbage and labeled TRASH.

Items Excluded from Regular Collection:

The following items cannot be collected: dirt, rocks, brick, concrete, liquid paints, fuels, oils, tires, pesticides, fertilizer, and batteries. Please contact us to discuss solutions for proper disposal of these items.

Holiday Schedule:

Texas Pride Disposal observes three holidays: New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. In the event that your service day falls on a holiday, collection will roll to the next regularly scheduled collection day.
