### What do the History Society do?

We are a Society for anyone interested in history. We put on a variety of both academic and social events to bring people with this shared interest together to help you feel at home here in Aberdeen. # What are your plans for in person events?

Currently, September 2020, Scottish Government and AUSA guidelines mean that we cannot host in person events for the foreseeable future. We will keep you updated as regulations change and AUSA have measures ready to keep people safe when we are able to have events together again.

# What events do you normally host?

Hopefully we'll be able to show you the full range of events that the History Society normally provides soon. Social events we host include pub crawls and pub quizzes around Aberdeen's town centre, movie nights with pizza and popcorn (which we may be able to do online), and trips out of the city to castles and other historic sites. We also host a lecture series with some lecturers from our department and guest lecturers on their specialist subjects, and these will continue online this term but with the ending discussion unfortunately not taking place in the Bobbin. We usually put on a ceilidh in first term and a ball in second term which is a tradition we look forward to returning to when we can. Additionally, we normally have Bonfires, pub nights, potlucks, non-drinking (or optional drinking) socials such as bowling and laser tag, and society meals such as our Christmas extravaganza and buffets. The list is truly endless, and we hope we can do more of this soon.

#### What events will you have this term?

Our lecture series, with a variety of resident and guest lectures talking on subjects from the history of Black Aberdeen to the Anglo-Scottish frontier in the medieval period, will be continuing online this year! Social events will continue too with pub quizzes, treasure hunts and more as we adapt to this term online. We also have an idea for a medieval recipe baking session which could either be fun or a disaster but well worth it either way. We still hope to collaborate with other societies, have drinking nights online, and give you all the opportunity to meet new people.
