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## **Please arrive on time — but not too early.**

To give every client a private, uninterrupted experience, please arrive at your scheduled time and no more than **5 minutes early**. Arriving too early may overlap another client's appointment.

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## **Bring the correct undergarments & shoes**

For the most accurate fit, please bring:

Your event shoes (or a shoe with the exact heel height)  
&

Any undergarments or shapewear you plan to wear on the day of.  
These items directly affect hem length, structure, and overall fit.

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
## **Light makeup recommended**

To help keep gowns clean, we recommend avoiding heavy makeup, lotions, or self-tanner during your fitting. Soft or minimal makeup is perfectly fine — it just helps protect your dress.

## *Studio Rules*

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### **Limit your guest count**

Our space is intimate and tailored for a calm fitting experience.

Please bring no more than **5 guests** to each fitting.

If you'd like to have more guests join you, we offer a special Final Reveal appointment for an additional fee.

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### **No food inside the fitting room; drinks must be spill-proof**

To keep gowns pristine, food must remain outside the fitting area.

Drinks are welcome only in spill-proof containers to prevent accidental drips or splashes.

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### **Children must remain seated with an adult**

We love little ones, but gowns, needles, and pins can be dangerous.

Children must stay seated with an accompanying adult at all times.

Also please no loud games or shows on speaker phone

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### **Respect the space & our team**

The Parlour is a working studio — it's where the magic happens. We appreciate your help in keeping the space tidy and respectful so we can continue creating beautiful gowns with care.
