Subj: Additional Engineering Best Practices Absent from the EIA-748 EVMS Standard

Dear Hon. Dep. Secretary of Defense Feinberg:

This letter augments my letter to you, subj: Your Memo, Reforming the Joint Requirements Process to Accelerate Fielding of Warfighting Capabilities, dated September 3, 2025. That letter cited the NDIA's exclusion of engineering practices in its draft SAE/EIA-748E Earned Value Management Systems (EVMS) Standard. My letters since September 3 are posted on my website. They include engineering best practices that should be in a system engineering or project management standard. Those letters are posted on the organizational pages and on the "EIA-748 EVMS Std. Status" pages.

My digitally transformed website, www.pb-ev.com, now includes letters reorganized by topic and by the individual responsible for implementing recommended acquisition reforms. The recommended fixers include military, legislative, and executive branch (OMB) leaders.
