We are so glad you and your church are part of our BIC family. We believe we are better together - joy is multiplied and challenges divided. As we work as a team we can do more then we ever could do alone. So thank you for leaning in. Here's a few notes from 2024...

- •Baptisms we saw many Baptisms across our churches celebrating new life in Christ;
- •Compassion our churches found many creative ways to bring blessing to their "place" food banks, shelters, helping people who experience illness or job loss, contributing to MCC, funding water wells .... the list goes on and on;
- •Leadership Development we raise up and train people for ministry success through our Elevate and Pastoral Residency programs;
- •Supporting Pastors we provide coaching, LEAD days, seminars, consultation, mentoring, clusters and retreats to encourage our Pastors and help them grow;
- •Church Plants and Re-starts our longing is for each church to thrive and that we would invest in new churches and new forms of ministry. In 2024 we worked intentionally with 3 established churches and 4 church plants.
- •Meeting House with loss of insurance in June countless hours were spent moving staff and sites into a new structure under the Sandbanks Church. Ongoing work is being done with each church in becoming healthy and self-sustaining. Sale of the Oakville building is pending;
- •Camp Kahquah we completed a major renovation and had a very successful year of kids and family camps, retreats and training leaders. Sr. High and Jr. High retreats for students were a great success. Kahquah serves us all memories are made and lives are changed;
- •Global Work we continued to support missions and supportive partnerships with other BIC National Churches. Short-term Teams are a key way to facilitate this as is our participation in both the International BIC Association and Mennonite World Conference;
- •Finding New Pastors With a number of Pastors retiring over the last couple of years we have worked in Pastoral Search with 6 congregations in 2024 to find and credential new Pastors. We are grateful to those who have served us well in Interim Pastoral work.
- •Advent Guide we produced our Christmas devotional "Who Did Jesus Come For?". The guide has become an annual tradition for our churches;
  - •Life support at the end of the day your local church is where you find your "people". It is where you belong, where you do life, where you care and are cared for, where you find encouragement and spiritual growth. We hope you also found great joy in Jesus there.

In 2025 we will observe the 500th anniversary of anabaptism. This milestone reminds us that we have both a wonderful past and a promising future. We are glad you can be part of the story God continues to write through our church.

### 2024 Financial Overview







A huge thank you for your financial support of the ministries of Delisle Community Church. For 2024 giving, there were 48 Receipts for Income tax purposes issued. Of those receipts issued, 15 of them were to our regular contributors. The total general offering was \$113,235.04, which was an increase \$794.33 over the previous year.

The fixed costs for payroll and occupancy were \$8716.73 per month in 2024. Unfortunately, the income in the months of January, February, April, May, July and August was less than that amount. The average cost for all aspects of Delisle Community Church was \$14,073.17 per month. Although many of the ministry costs (ie. VBS, Motorcycle Sunday, Men's Fishing Trip, Women's retreat, BIC events in Ontario) occur only in specific months, our income exceeded that amount June, October and December. This meant that the church had to dip into reserves throughout the year to pay our bills.

We know that God is working in and around Delisle and using Delisle Community Church in accomplishing what He is doing. We appreciate your financial support of the church in our ministry in this area and seek your prayerful continued support in 2025.
