Tribute to Texas Master Coloring Kit

This is the master list of colors that I used for these blocks however I could have easily colored all the blocks with just the small Fabric 101 Color kit... I have listed what I believe to be the best substitute from the small Color kit.)

For the Markers, I suggest that you purchase the cheapest acrylic marker and purchase several of them to make sure you have enough for all 9 blocks. Or, if you prefer, you can use #117 pencil for #20 marker; #18 pencil for #21 and #17 pencil for #22 pen.

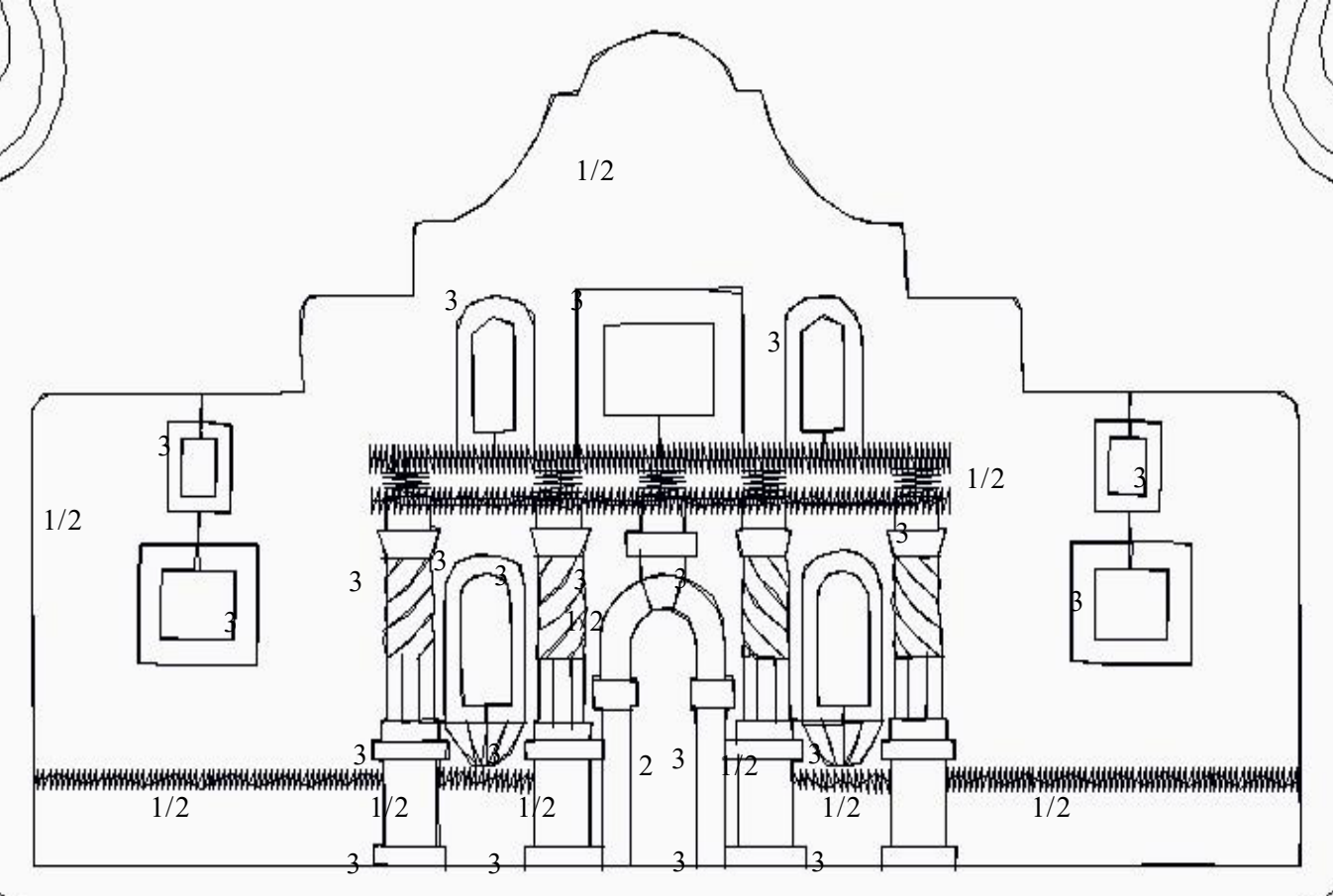

The Alamo Block



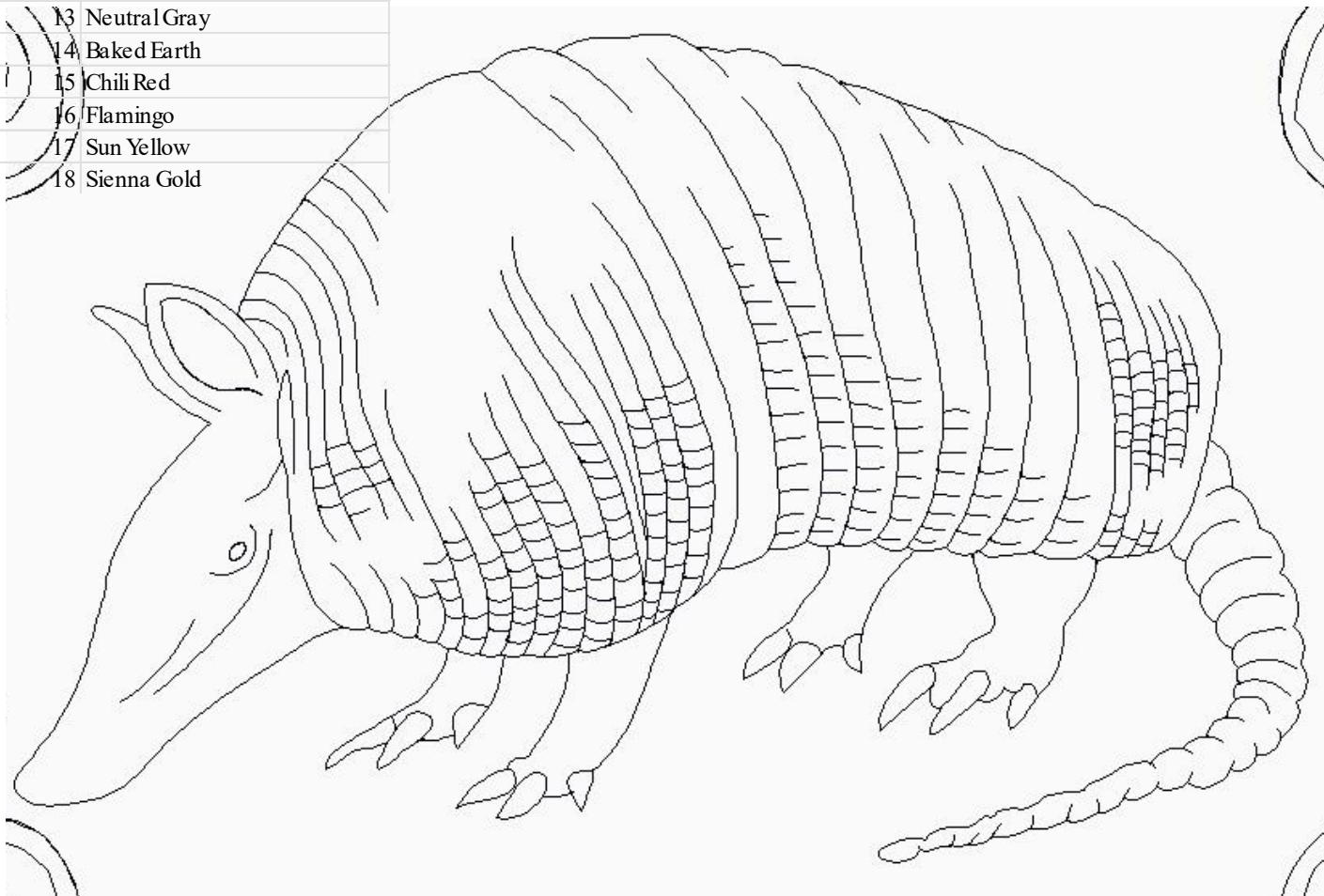


The Main building should be colored first with #1 the overcolored with #2 to make it look weathered and worn. Be sure to scrub the two colors together with fabric medium.

The Armadillo Block

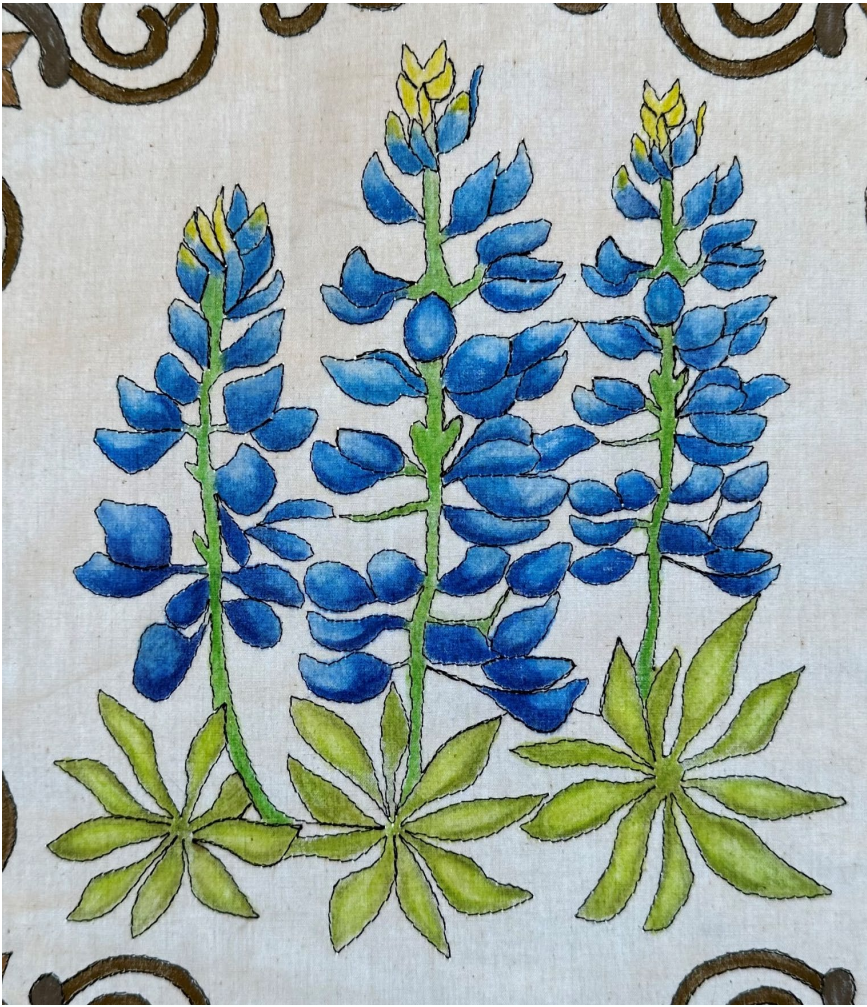
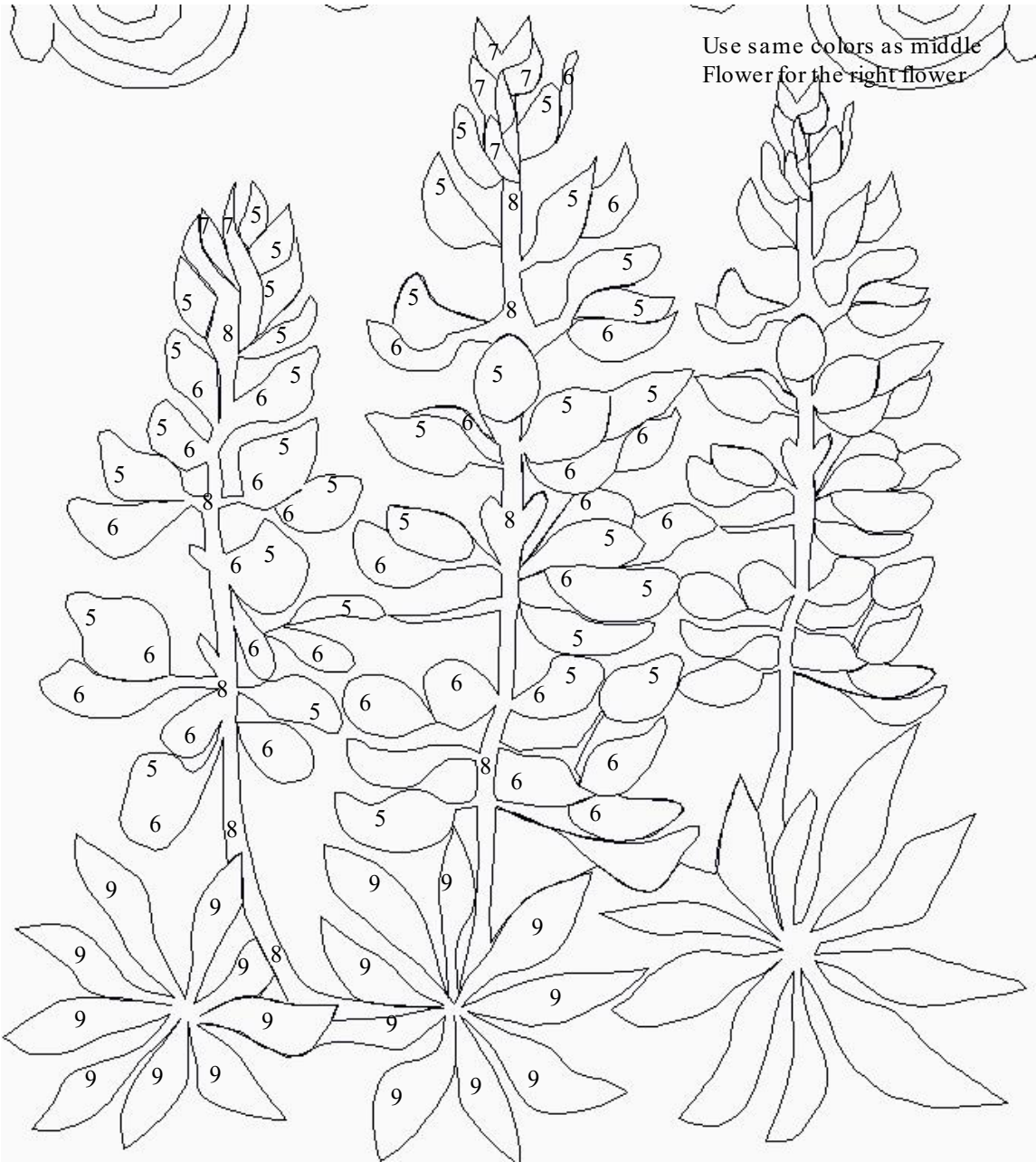


Color the entire armadillo body with # 11
Or use #12 very lightly to achieve a light gray
Tone. Use #12 to color back of neck, under
Belly, toes and a few of the creases in the body.
Use #2 to put some brown highlights on the
Center of the body and a bit on the tail.
Use #16 for the ear or #1.

Three Bluebonnets

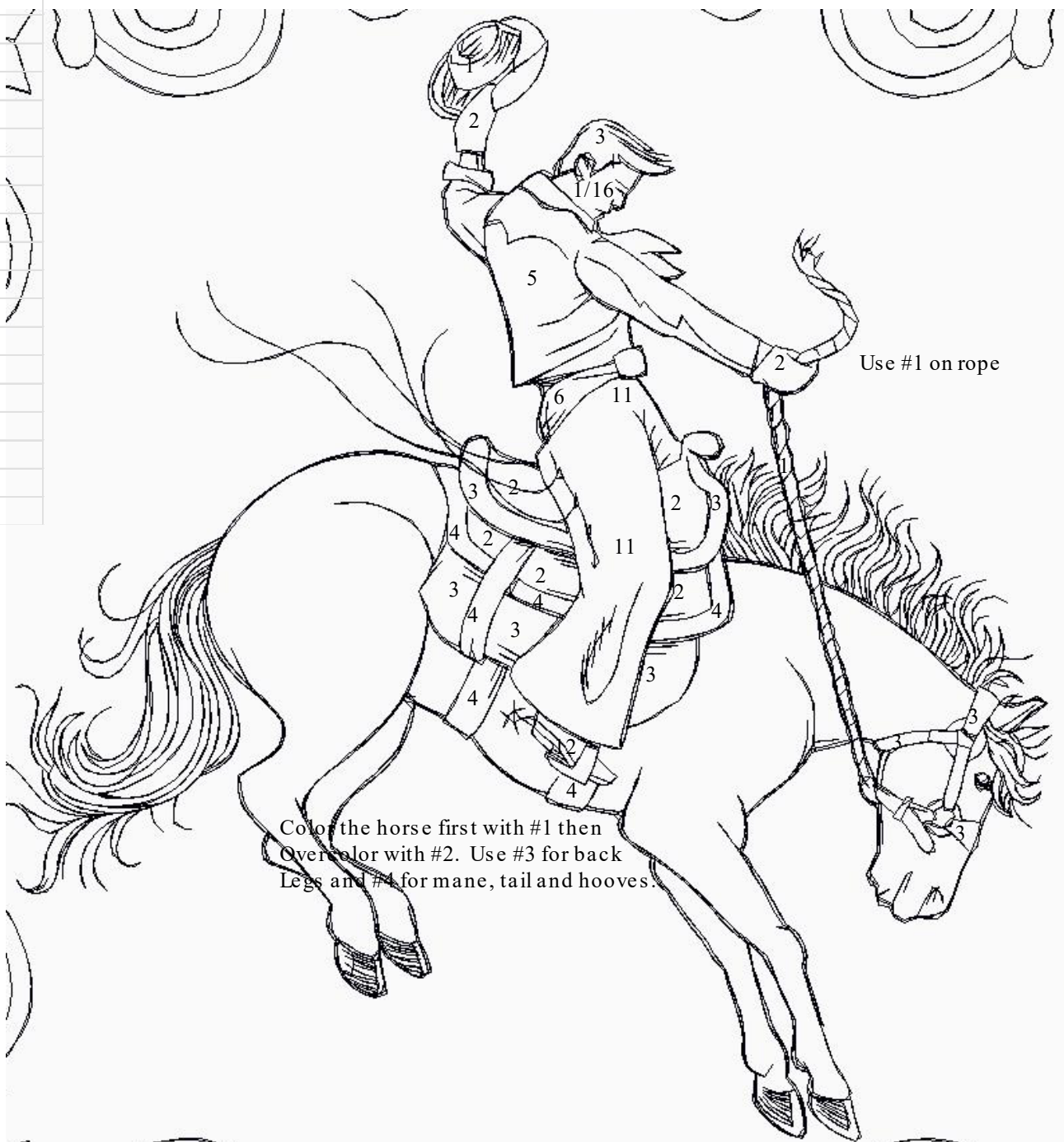
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8	Felt Green
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Use #7 in the center of the leaves first to provide some contrast in the leaf.

Colors together with fabric medium.

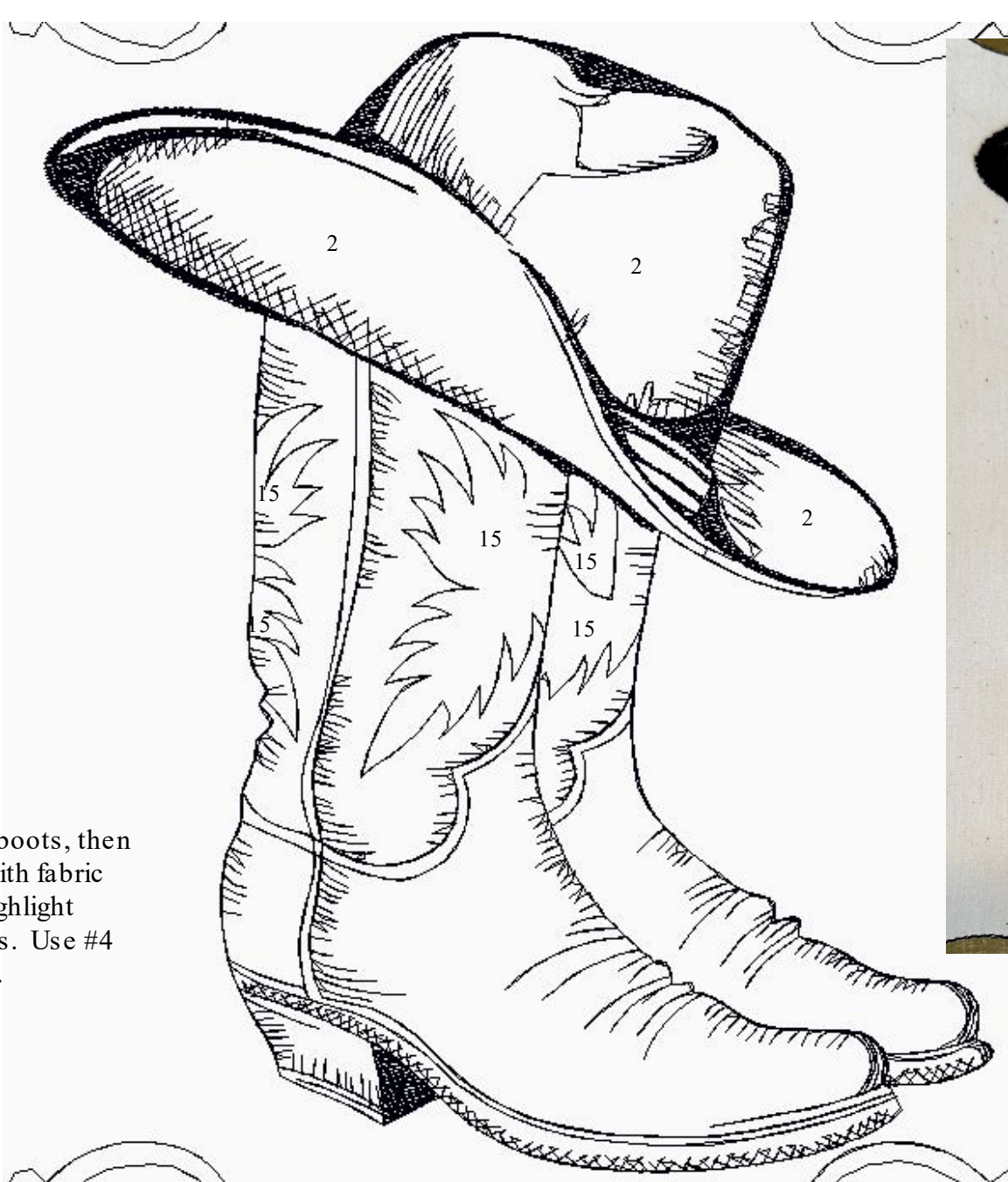




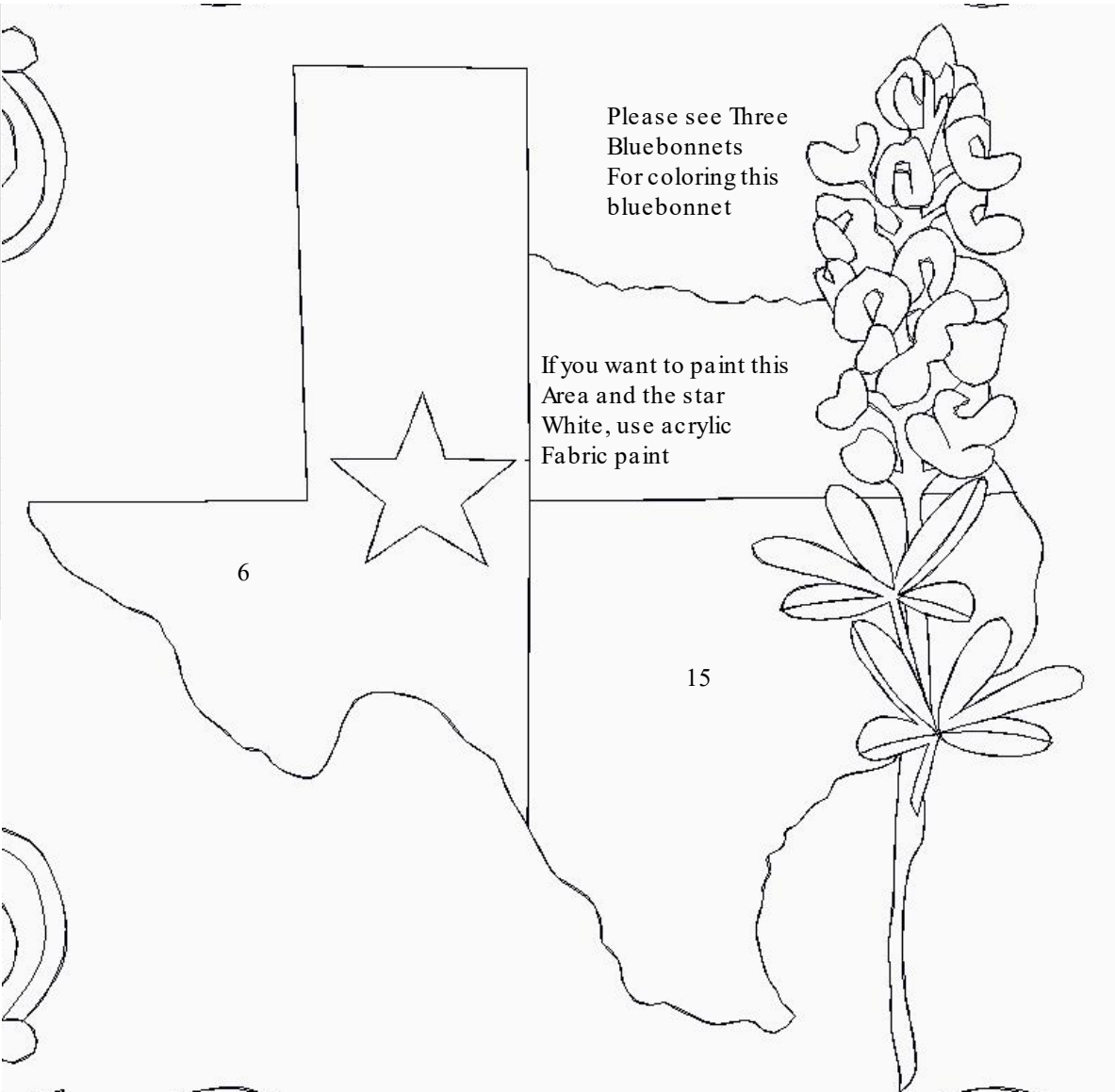
Inktense Pencil Colors

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Use #3 first on the cowboy boots, then Overcolor with #3. Blend with fabric Medium. Then use #3 to highlight Seams and creases in boots. Use #4 For heel and soles of boots.

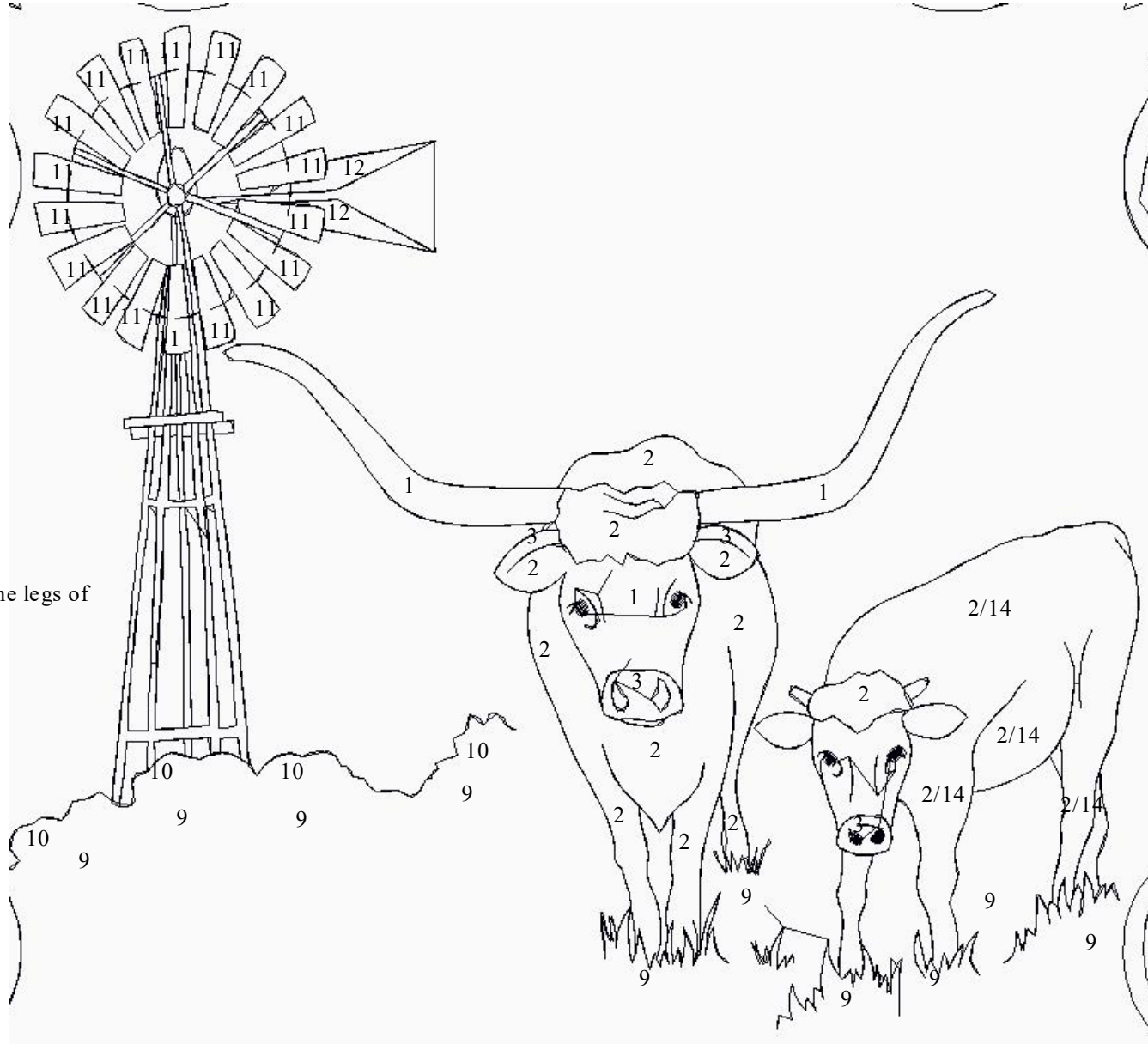

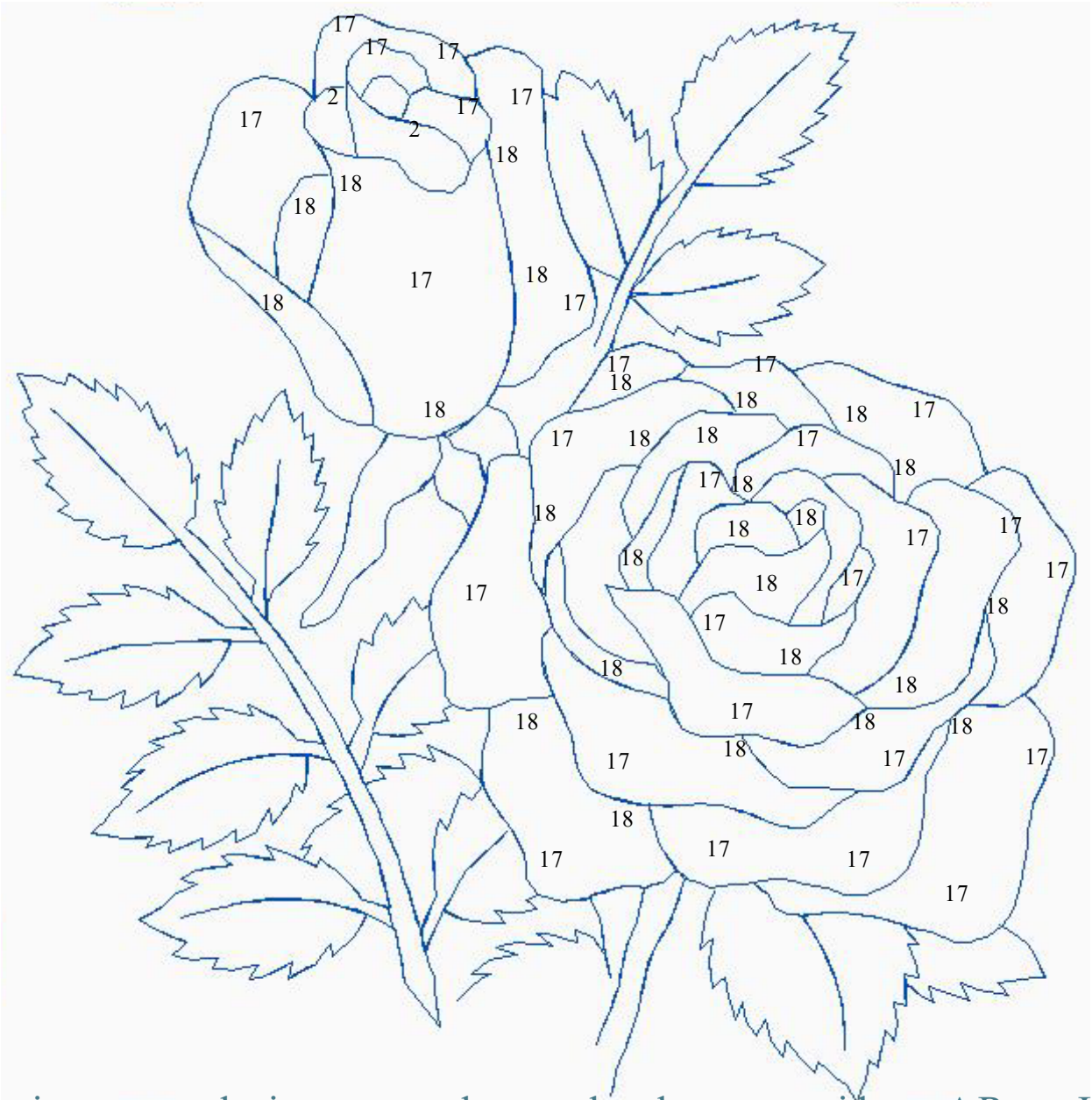

For the calf, use #2 first then overcolor lightly with #14 on the body and heavier on the legs.

Color the leaves first with #9 lightly
