Color Codes for Pagather 48 Dual-Tip Acrylic Markers

One of the biggest difficulties in using Acrylic Markers (particularly those made in China) is that the markers are usually NOT Numbered or coded in any way. I have used These markers with great success however, and Want to illustrate how I have used them with Many of the blocks and DTFs I have colored.

These markers work very well with denim and it is why I recommend them. When sealed with Fabric medium and heat set, the color does Not wash out after repeated washings.

For my class instructions, I have opted to use This set of markers (and the Betem 24 marker set) As my baseline for color codes. Not only are The markers great for coloring on denim, they are Relatively inexpensive and available on Amazon.

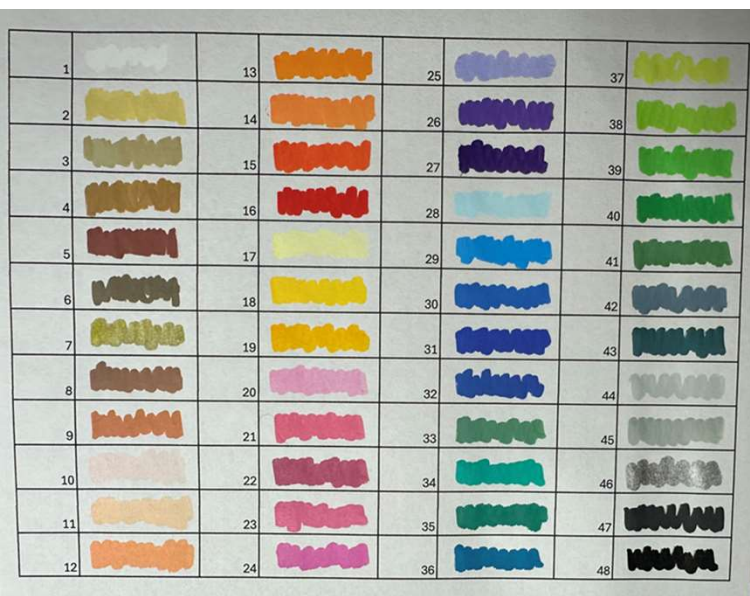

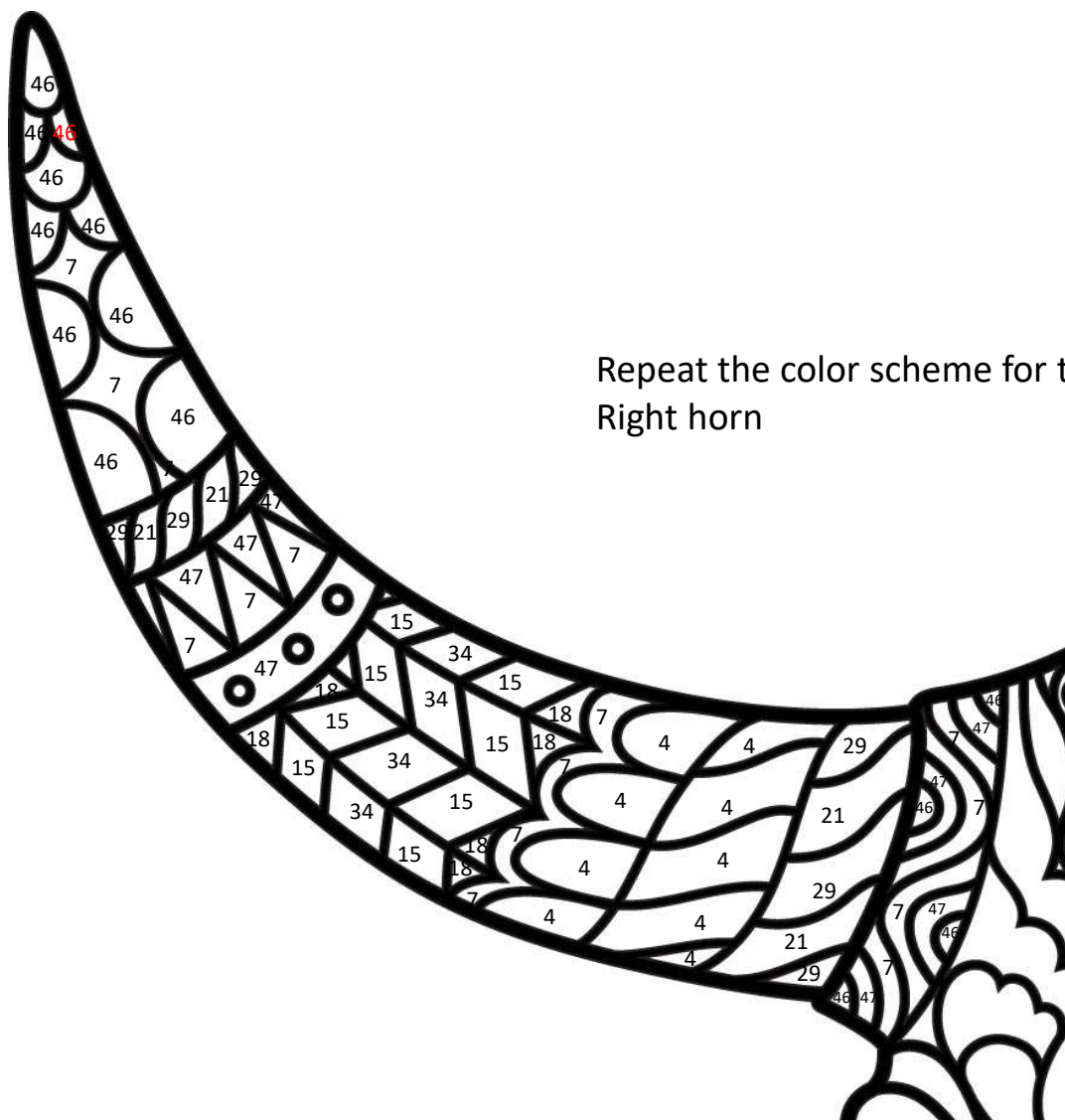

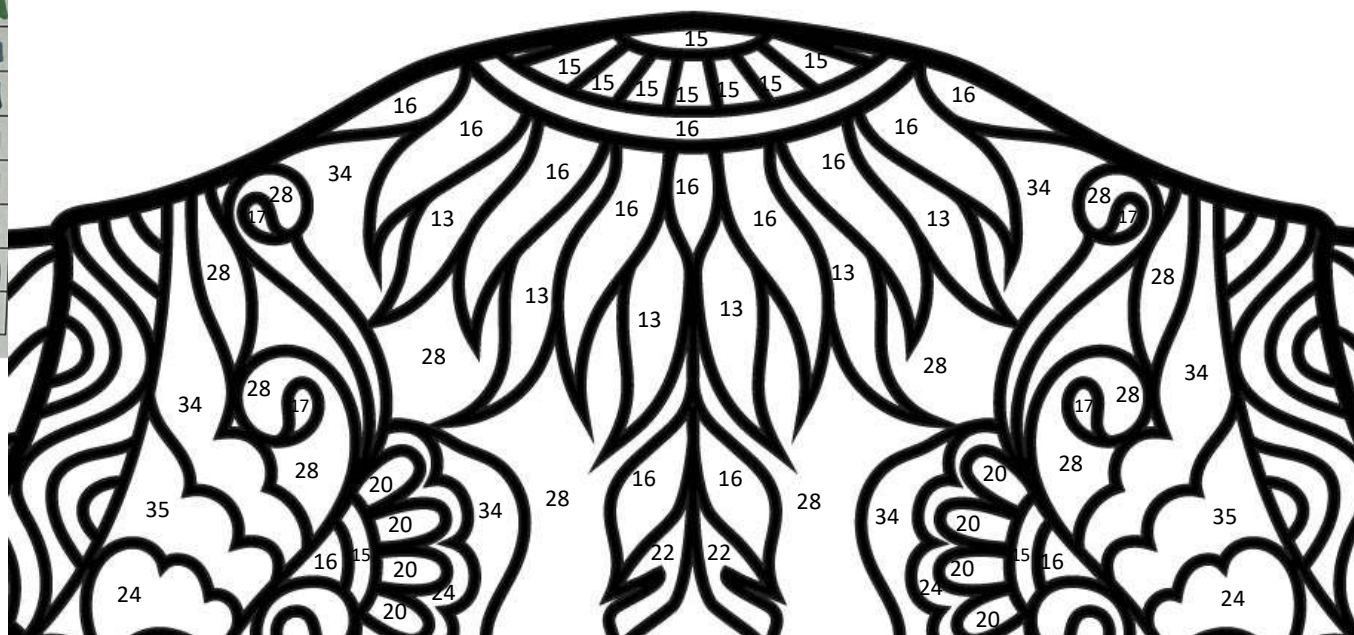

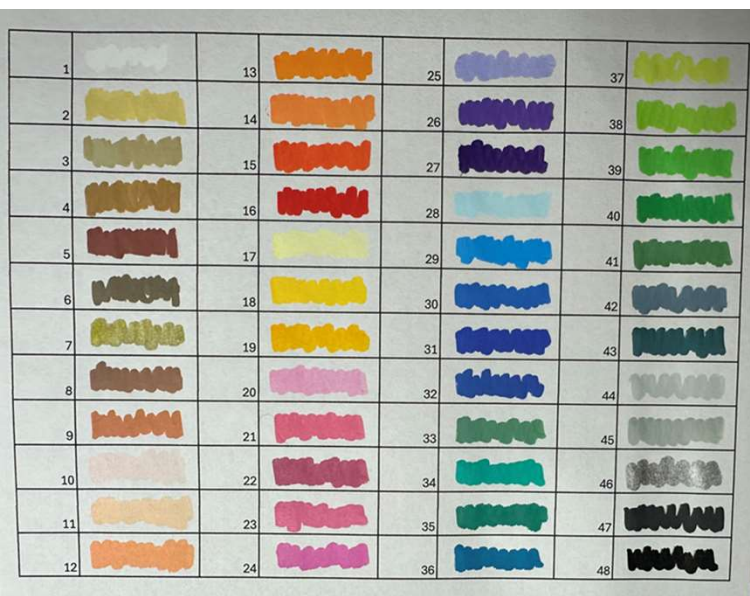


Repeat the color scheme for the
Right horn



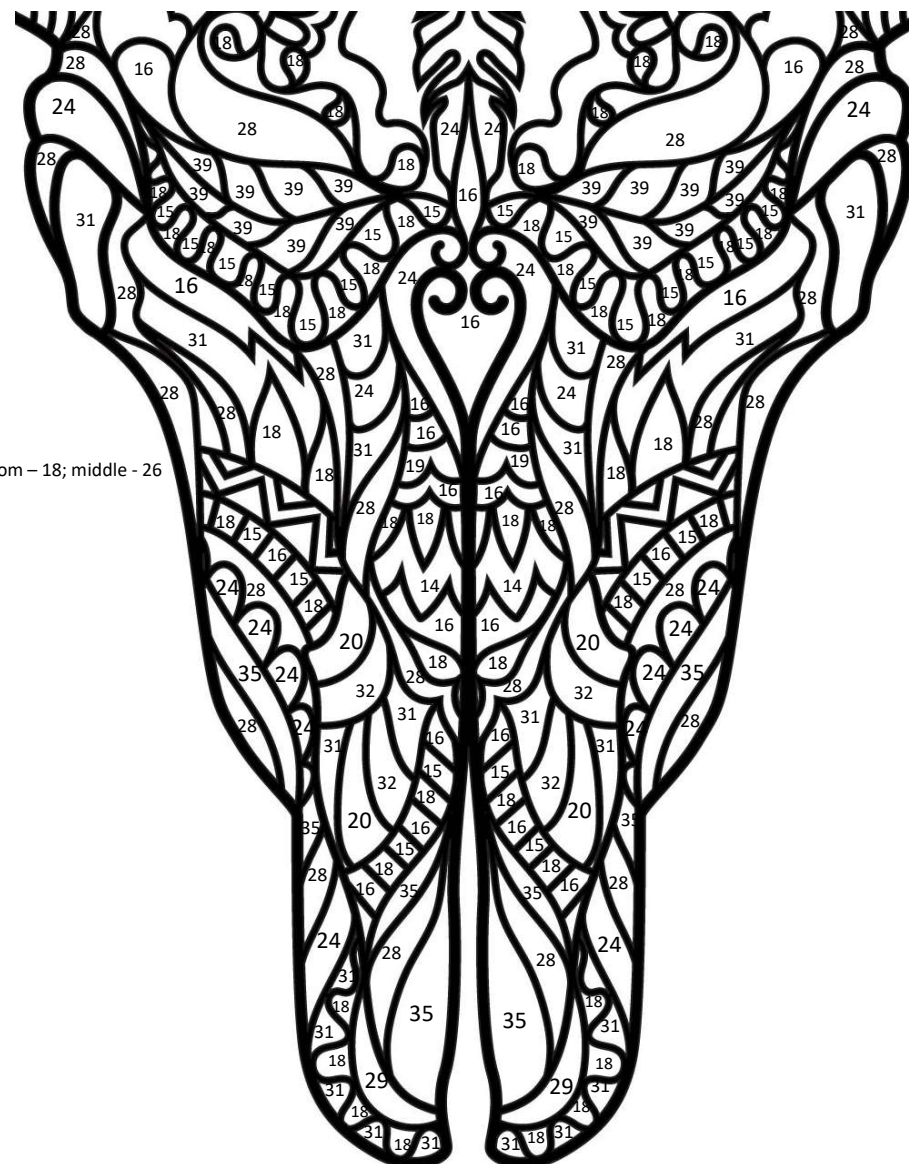
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Zig Zag pattern: top and bottom – 18; middle - 26
