Michele saw her first long arm in 2002 and vowed one day she would have her own long arming business. She got her wish when she retired from the oil and gas industry in 2009 to start her own quilting business AND fabric store. (Sometimes you should be careful of what you wish for!) After three years of running both businesses, she sold the fabric business to focus on the long arm offering custom quilting and embroidery, machine rentals, long arm and coloring fabric classes and custom digitizing. For the last 7 years Michele has been teaching classes both to groups and one-on-one in her studio, in quilt shops and in private homes.

Coloring on Fabric Classes

Several years back while attending the Houston Quilt Show I met Sherry Rogers Harrison, another Innova quilter, who completely painted her wholecloth quilts. Intrigued, I took classes from Sherry as well as Linda Poole (another incredibly talented fabric painter). I was hooked! Since then, I have developed a niche – painting long arm and embroidery patterns (often redwork or lined designs). As more of my long arm clients saw the end product, they too wanted to learn how to color on fabric. So, I began to teach and developed a series of single and Block of the Month classes that range from beginner to expert as well as various price ranges.

Fabric Painting 101 Class

Want to learn how to color on fabric? But don't want to spend a lot of money on supplies? Then this is the class for you! All you have to do is show up! We provide a 12 to 16 inch fabric block or canvas bag, a complete coloring tool box, bling and printed instructions. You will learn multiple coloring and painting techniques using fabric markers, Inktense pencils, paints and fabric medium. When the class is done you will have a beautiful block to use in a quilt, pillow or on a bag. Class fee is a single fee (see each kit's price) and covers everything. This is the recommended class that everyone should take first before tackling one of the fabric painting kit classes.

Class size: minimum of 5 students if venue is located within 2 hours of my studio OR minimum of 10 students if located 2 hours or greater from my studio. Maximum number of students is 20.
