Henna Flamingo Block Coloring and Bling Kit Instructions


Recommended Coloring Materials:
The Flamingo is done exclusively with fabric and gel pen markers. The following is a list of recommended colors but are not exclusive. More pink pens can be added if so desired:

Gelly Roll Pens: Black Metallic (\#549) for Beak; Gold Stardust (\#703 for legs); Gold Metallic (\#551 for legs); Pink Stardust (\#720); Pink Metallic (\#520); Pink Moonlight (\#21)

Fabrico Fabric Markers: Lipstick Pink, Cherry Pink, Garnet, Bubble Gum
Kaisercolour Gel Pens: 5 pastels in Pinks and Orange Pasteles


The flamingo is a wide variety of pinks, dark pinks, burgundy and Orange Pastel colors. In order to create a "color by number" system for the flamingo, I have numbered the picture above with numbers for each pen. I have never colored the flamingo the same

The colors are in order relative to the picture to the left. so the coloring may look slightly different than the picture provided. Due to limited availability I will substitute colors when necessary. Kit pens will be numbered in order to use correct substitution.

Use the Black and White Version of each flamingo section attached to test colors first and to set up a color code chart before coloring on sampler. In the case of the flamingo you may want to make several copies of the black and white version and color it several times to determine the best color combo. No fabric medium is necessary for coloring this block.

Bling Kit - the bling kit for the flamingo is the most complex of the Animals Gone Zen series. The flamingo design has been broken down into sections and labeled carefully with names of stones and the number of stones used in each band.

Bling Kit (all the stones necessary to bling according to the photo included in kit. Please note that there are just a few extra stones of each color so be careful when handling the rhinestones).

Iron or Mini Iron. The best way to attach most of these stones is with a mini iron preferably one that has a rhinestone tip. A regular iron can be used but may prove to be cumbersome when setting the very smallest stones.

Pair of tweezers for placing the stones. Any tweezer will do but I find that embroidery tweezers or medical supply tweezers at least $4.5^{\prime \prime}$ long work the best.

Roxanne's Baste it with the small nozzle for precise glue placement. Although the stones are all hot fix (meaning that the glue on the stone is activated by heat), I found it somewhat easier to put a spot of Roxanne's Baste it glue down, place the stone on the glue then let the glue dry (for about 5 minutes). Then hit the stone with your iron or mini iron. The Baste it glue holds the stone exactly where you want so you can place the iron on it without worry of the stone shifting under the iron.

There is no particular step by step process other than it is easier to color first then place the stones. Always place your smaller stones first then the larger stones so that the iron can touch the surface completely. Make sure to heat set the coloring first before placing stones. The photo included should be the best guide for coloring as well as where exactly to place stones. However, there are detailed diagrams of each part of the design labeled with number associated with a particular stone and pencil for coloring. Please see the Excel spreadsheet printout for the rhinestone name, the size and the color code for each stone. I have also provided a close count of how many stones are used throughout the process.

If you are having difficulty setting the stones (i.e., they don't seem to stick once heat activated) you may want to refer to the VERY DETAILED instructions provided by the following link:

7. Large area behind eye Fabrico Bubblegum Pink
8. Ovals and area under eye Fabrico Apricot
9. Row 1 on neck Gelly Roll Stardust Pink
10. Row 2 on neck Gelly Roll Moonlight \#420
11. Row 3 on neck Fabrico Bubblegum Pink

1. Feathered area with triangles Triangles in Fabrico Apricot and Pink then outside area in Fabrico Bubblegum Pink
2. $2^{\text {nd }}$ band of feathers - Gelly Roll Stardust Pink
3. $3^{\text {rd }}$ band of feathers - Gelly Roll Moonlight \#420
4. Top 3 feathers - Fabrico Bubblegum Pink
5. Section of feathers with ovals in center -Gelly Roll Moonlight \#420 in ovals and Fabrico Bubblegum Pink in outside area
6. Top ridge of feathers above feathers with ovals - Fabrico Cherry Pink with an overlay of Gelly Roll Stardust Pink
7. Lower bands near legs - Use alternating colors of the Kaiser colors and Fabrico Burgandy
8. Small section under feathers to the right of lower bands near legs:
a. $1^{\text {st }}$ Section - Fabrico Cherry pink
b. Gelly Roll Moonlight \#420 in ovals
c. Middle Section - Gelly Roll Moon Pink
d. End Section - Fabrico Lipstick Pink

Bling:

1. Feathered area with triangles: Swar Indian Pink SS12-19
2. $2^{\text {nd }}$ band of feathers: Swar Lt Pink SS8-21
3. $3^{\text {rd }}$ band of feathers: Swar Indian Pink SS6-11
4. Top 3 feathers: Swar Pink Alabaster SS10-11
5. Section of feathers with ovals in center:
a. Bottom part of feathers:

Crystal AB SS10-52
b. Center Ovals: TA Fuchsia SS6 - 23
c. Top Part of Feathers:

Preciosa Lt Pink SS6-51
6. Top ridge of feathers above feathers with ovals: TA Fuchsia SS6-53

## Coloring

Starting at top of back:

1. Row 1 with chevron stripes - Use all colors starting with Fabrico darks through Kaiser Lights
2. Row 2 solid - Fabrico Bubblegum Pink
3. Row 3 squares - All Fabrico pens starting with Dark to Light then back to Dark
4. Row 4 with diamonds - Gelly Roll Moonlight \#405 in diamonds and Gelly Roll Moonlight \#420 in outside area
5. Row 5 small long triangles - Gelly Roll Moonlight \#405 in small skinny triangles and Kaiser Gelly Roll Moonlight \#418 in outside area
6. Row 6 swirls - Fabrico Bubblegum Pink in swirls and Fabrico Burgandy in outside area
7. Row 7 bowties - Gelly Roll Moonlight \#420 in Bowties and Fabrico Cherry Pink in outside area
8. Row 8 solid - Fabrico Apricot
9. Tip of tail with diagonal lines starting at back end of tip to last end (7 diagonal rows) -
a. Row 1 - Fabrico Garnet
b. Row 2 - Fabrico Burgandy
c. Row 3 - Fabrico Lipstick Pink
d. Row 4-Gelly Roll Stardust Pink
e. Row 5 - Fabrico Apricot
f. Row 6-Gelly Roll Moonlight \#420
g. Row 7-Gelly Roll Moonlight \#420
h. Row 8-Gelly Roll Metallic Pink

a. TA Fuchsia SS6-10
b. Swar Padpara SS8-5

2. Row 2 solid: RG Prem Pink SS10-20
3. Row 3 squares: Stone Mix SS10-32
4. Row 4 with diamonds: Swar Lt Peach SS12-12
5. Row 5 small long triangles: na
6. Row 6 swirls: 7 RG Prem Fuchsia SS10 in swirls \& Swar Burgandy SS8-17 in outside area
7. Row 7 bowties: Swar Lt Pink SS8-15
8. Row 8 solid: Swar Lt Peach SS16-8
9. Tip of tail with diagonal lines
a. Row 2 - Preciosa Padpara SS10-2
b. Row 3-Swar Burgandy SS84
c. Row 4-Swar Indian Pink SS8 - 5
d. Row 5 - Preciosa Lt Pink SS6 7
e. Row 6-Swar Indian Pink SS6 - 7
f. Row 7-RG Prem Pink SS105
g. Row 8-TA Fuchsia SS6-3


## Coloring of the Legs

Use Alternating colors of Gelly Roll Stardust Gold and Gelly Roll Metallic Gold for legs. No bling is used on legs. Use Fabrico Marker Sand (check each end for the lightest color as sometimes the markers have different colors!) If you do not like the sand color of legs, you can use Prismacolor watercolor pencils (Cream, Blush Pink, Light Peach) for different shades of beige.
