The symbols 2/3 means color the #2 first then use # 3 to highlight or outline the edges of area. See colored picture as reference.

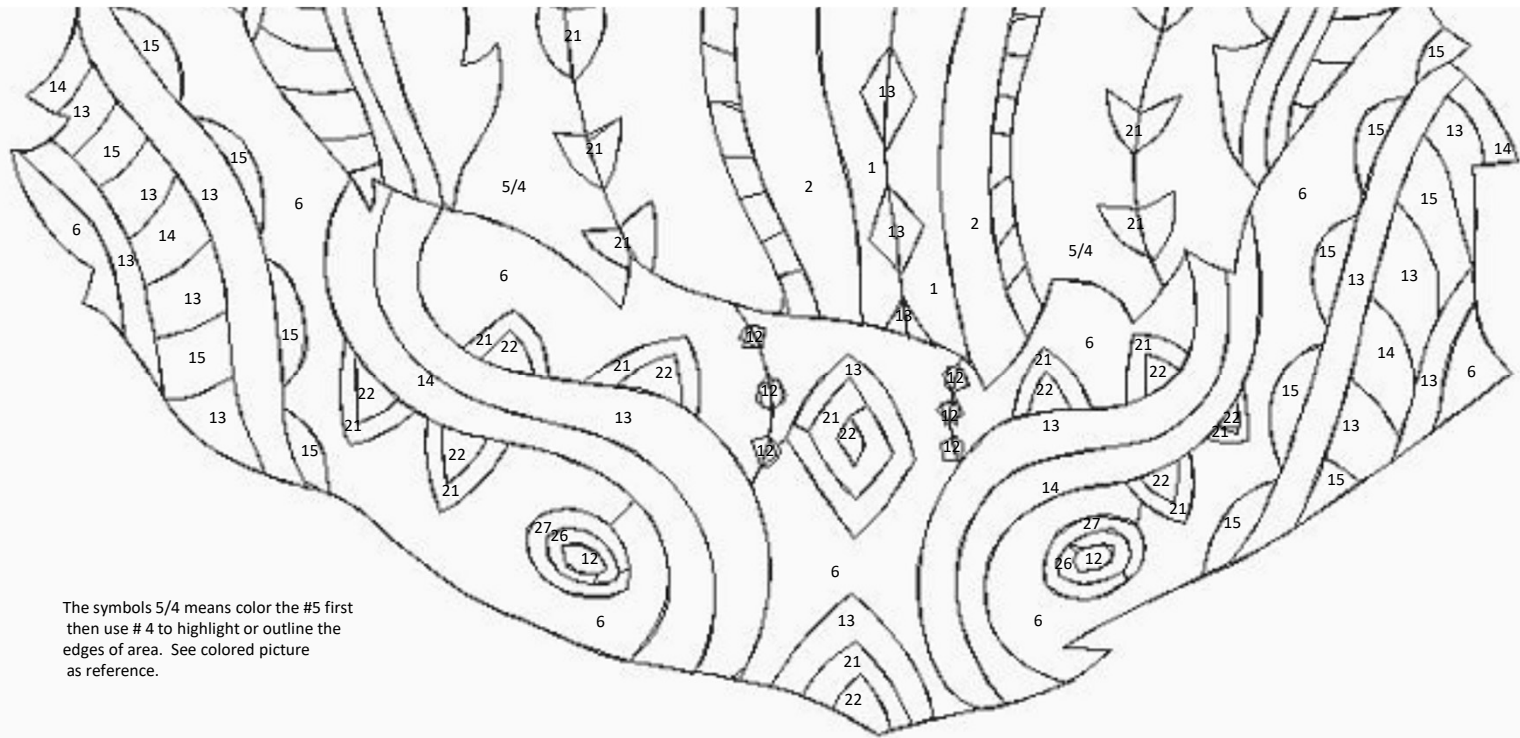
