Applications are valid for 2 months. Too many people move on if we don't have anything available so if after 2 months have passed and you have not gotten a puppy, you need to renew your interest so we know you are still looking. We can't keep track of everyone looking for a puppy a year down the road, who went and got a puppy elsewhere ect.

Puppy deposits of \$500 are accepted usually about 5 to 6 weeks of age. Puppies are usually ready to go 8 to 9 weeks of age. They cannot leave before 8 weeks of age, no exceptions. Order of picks are based on order of application received. We will call you and by then you have seen the puppies and should have an idea of which puppies you might like so no waiting a few days to decide as others are waiting to make their picks.

ALL puppies are sold as Pet Only with no breeding rights with spay/ neuter contract.
