April 11, 2017 Meeting Notes

President Chris Robinson called the meeting to order at 7:30pm.

Marshall District Supervisor Mary Leigh McDaniel said the Marshall Middle School Science Fair two weeks ago went wonderfully.

There is a Marshall Main Street Meeting on 5/3 at 6pm in the Community Center. Open to everyone. VDOT to give an update and suggest how to help parking. A possibility they are thinking of is two hour timed parking on Main Street.

Mark Nesbit is considering a smaller roundabout at Frost to slow traffic.

Lastly, there is an emergency ordinance to propose changing the location of the polling place for June. The polling place will be at the Marshall Community Center for now.

President Chris Robinson said that he has received calls from William Skinker and Tom Marable who would like to address the MBRA to set the record straight, as there are newspaper articles out that do not convey all the information. Our first speaker of the night was **Fauquier Heritage and Preservation Foundation President, Bob Sinclair**. He explained that they are about to move in to the second building next door and are seeking docents. FHPF started in 1993, meeting in George Thompson's little building by the railroad tracks. Then, thanks to Mr. Thompson, they moved to their current location behind the Marshall Ford dealership, the John Gott Library.

The FHPF has 6,500 books and 1,600 period photographs at the John Gott Library, so Bob encouraged everyone to stop in and see what history they might find about themselves. This main building dates back to c. 1771. FHPF is completely volunteer-run, and is supported by private funds. They are open on Mondays, Tuesdays, and

Wednesdays. Bob explained that their ultimate goal is to be open everyday, but they do not have enough folks for that right now. He also distributed a handout of the FHPF's needs and emphasized it is not necessary to know history in order to volunteer with them. Bob is usually in the office from around 8am-12:30 or 1pm. The Gott Library can be reached at 540-364-3440, and Bob's cell phone is 703-403-1309.

Patrick Workman of the Marshall Community Center spoke about the Annual Health Fair on October 7th of this Year. A cross country 5k at the park and utilizing some of the school grounds will begin in the morning of 10/7/17, and the Health Fair will be at the Community Center in the afternoon. There is no cost if one would like to have an informational table at the Fair. The sponsorship costs cover shirts and promotional materials. With the idea of a Marshall Day, they are looking to open the doors of Main Street. Possibly businesses could have a table outside, and be included in a pamphlet. They would like input on parking comments and ideas for the day of the Fair. They need a representative from the MBRA to address that issue with each business so that they Fair does not take business away. They are also looking at having a passport booklet that would direct Fair-goers to local businesses. Patrick invited the public to stop by the committee meetings for the Health Fair that are held on the third Monday of every month at 6:30pm right here in this community center room.

Lastly, Patrick announced that on 6/10, they will be dedicating a bench to Lorraine Bridges outside.

Our next speaker was **Scott Kim, owner of Mayson's Pharmacy** that opened just three weeks ago. In the 1990s, Mr. Kim lived in Fairfax, and in 2009, he was at VCU. He then worked for Walgreens for several years, and in 2013, Mr. Kim opened his first pharmacy in Farmville,

two & a half hours away from Marshall. The Farmville pharmacy started out at 30 prescriptions per week and has since been going very well. So Mr. Kim looked where to go for his next pharmacy. He chose Marshall because the only pharmacy in town had closed, and in Marshall there are both dentists and doctors. Mr. Kim wants to give the people of Marshall options so they do not have to drive far.

Mayson's Pharmacy fills prescriptions, can order medication and have it delivered to the pharmacy the next day. Rather than spending \$300,000 on inventory for it to just sit there, he will order medications for customers and have it the next day. Sally, a full-time tech who lives in Marshall, has just been hired. The Pharmacy accepts all insurances, though there may be some price differences. If Mayson's Pharmacy expands their square footage in the future, they may then offer compounding medicines.

Pharmacy hours are Mon-Fri 9am-6pm, Sat 10am-2pm, and closed on Sunday. Call them at 540-364-8291.

Jeff Payne of TPI Containers, a roll off construction company, spoke next. Jeff explained that they have 20-yard containers, equal to six pick-up truck loads. They have 37 dumpsters and 2 trucks, and service all counties that border Fauquier, except Prince William County. TPI works with homeowners, contractors, etc. They have 30-day rentals, but their containers can be picked up in fewer than 30 days. Part of the cost is a flat delivery fee and County tonnage fee. 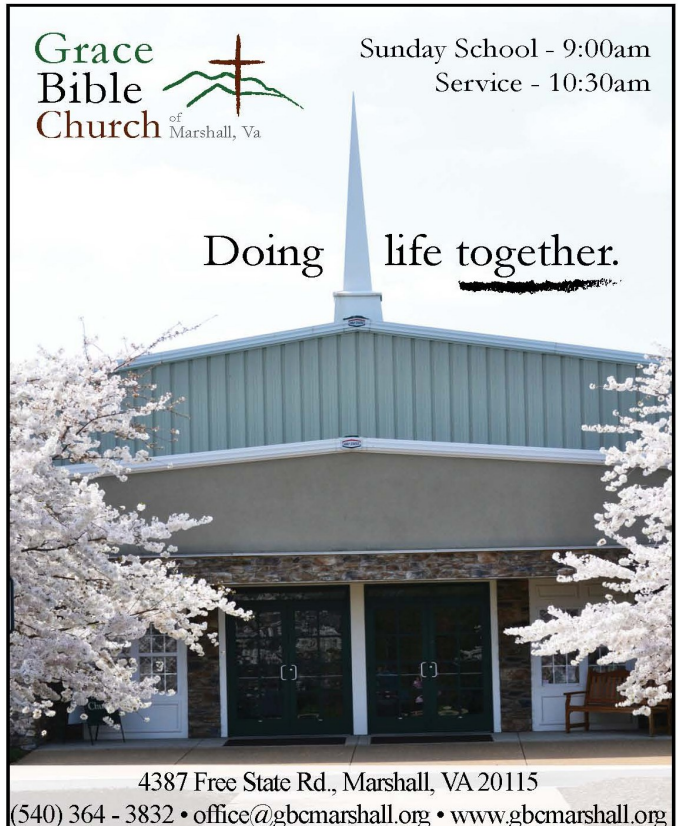
