This Is My Father's World

"This is My Father's World" was written by Maltbie Davenport Babcock and was published after his death in 1901. It was originally written as a poem containing sixteen verses of four lines each. Franklin L. Sheppard set the poem to music in 1915 and selected three verses for the final hymn. Babcock, who was a minister from Lockport, New York, would often take walks overlooking a cliff. As he prepared to leave for his walks he would often tell his wife that he was "going out to see my Father's world."

"This Is The Day"

'This Is the Day' celebrates God's mighty acts of redemption (originally referring to the Passover before the Exodus), hailing 'the day' as a special day of the Lord." In other words, the reference is not just to any day but, for the Christian, Sunday—the Lord's Day.

Open The Eyes of My Heart

Paul Balouche says the song was inspired in part by Ephesians 1:18. "The Apostle Paul was writing a letter to the Ephesians and he says, 'I pray that the eyes of your heart would be enlightened.' That verse stirred in my heart. One morning, while playing during a ministry time at my church, I began to sing that phrase over and over again: 'Open the eyes of my heart, Lord. Open the eyes of my heart.' The whole song pretty much rolled off my tongue while prayerfully playing my guitar and singing out to Him. It really is a simple song that reflected the sincere prayer of my heart."
