"Do you not know that you are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells within you?" 1 CORINTHIANS 3:16

Simply remembering that we are "temples of the Holy Spirit" should make our daily decision making relatively easy. If we truly want to imitate Jesus, then our words and actions should reflect the love, mercy, and forgiveness that flow from His heart. Try it for one week. Try to remember that we are temples of the Holy Spirit and see how it affects the way that you live.

Soon and Very Soon

The gospel song "Soon and Very Soon" was written in 1976 by the influential gospel artist Andraé Crouch. Its lyrics are based on the biblical promise of Christ's second coming, particularly Revelation 21:3-4, which speaks of an end to suffering and death. Though many people assume it is an old traditional hymn, it was composed much later and became popular for its hopeful, repetitive, and easy-to-sing style, reminiscent of traditional spirituals.

Jesus Calls Us O'er The Tumult

The hymn "Jesus Calls Us o'er the Tumult" was written by Cecil Frances Alexander in 1852 for St. Andrew's Day, inspired by the scripture of Jesus calling his disciples. Her husband, Reverend William Alexander, requested she write a poem based on the day's gospel reading, and she was inspired by the account of the disciples leaving their nets to follow Christ.

Blessed Assurance

The hymn "Blessed Assurance" was written in 1873 by blind hymn writer Fanny Crosby and composer Phoebe Knapp. Crosby was visiting her friend Knapp, who played a new melody on the piano and asked Crosby, "What does this tune say?". Crosby instantly replied, "Blessed assurance, Jesus is mine!" and the two friends spent the afternoon collaborating to create the rest of the lyrics, which Crosby dictated to Knapp.
