What is the Winter Showcase?

Our Winter Showcase: Holiday Hearts is a special annual tradition here at Dixon Dance Studio, offering our dancers the chance to shine on stage and celebrate the holiday season with our dance family. It's an exciting performance experience where students can show what they've learned during the first half of the year. Each class will perform a dance that has been taught during their regular class time, with no additional rehearsals required except for one final rehearsal during showcase week. The Winter Showcase is a wonderful way to practice performing in front of an audience and a fun, festive way to ring in the holidays! It's also a great introduction to the larger productions we hold, like our summer recital.

Is there a costume?

Yes! Costumes are a fun and exciting part of the Winter Showcase experience. Each dancer has been measured for their costume during class time, and our teachers work together to choose the perfect outfit for each performance. Once the costumes arrive, they will be distributed at the end of class. Dancers will be responsible for providing the proper dance shoes and tights (if applicable). A costume guide will be created to help you gather all of the required items.

Do I get to keep the costume?

Yes! The costume is yours to keep. After they've been delivered to the studio and distributed to the dancers, the costumes are theirs to take home.

How do I buy tickets?

Tickets will be sold directly through the DanceStudio-Pro parent portal. You can find the ticket link on our website, on social media, in the newsletters, or directly in your parents portal.

Can I videotape the showcase?

To ensure the best quality and experience for everyone, video and photography are not allowed during the Winter Showcase performance. However, a professional videographer will record one of the performances, and the video link will be made available to you. The cost for the video link is included in your dancer's participation fee.

<u>Showcase Week: December 9th - December</u> <u>15th</u>

Leading up to the performance dates, we will have one DRESS REHEARSAL at the theater. Regular classes will not take place at Dixon Dance Studio during showcase week, except for Monday classes on Monday, December 9th.

Thursday, December 12th: Dress Rehearsal

Dancers will come to the theater in full costume and makeup. In addition to giving the dancers practice on stage with their costumes, this rehearsal also allows our staff an opportunity to practice the technical aspects of the show, like lighting, music, and transitions.

<u>Pajama Week: December 16 - December 20</u> After the showcase, the studio will be open for one more week of regular classes where we will have a special pajama week. After that we will take a two week break from regular classes. We will resume with our regular classes, and our Spring 2025 season on Monday, January 6, 2025.
