For 35 years, Tuscaloosa Children's Theatre has provided high-quality arts education, community engagement, and live entertainment to the children and families of West Alabama. But like so many other artists, the 2020 pandemic hit TCT hard. It closed the curtains on our 2019-2020 season and canceled our 2020-2021 season. Our commitment to TCT's mission of providing arts education took us in unexpected directions the past 20 months, providing an outdoor variety show and three online productions. Indeed, we have much to celebrate – returning to live performances, reconnecting with you, re-engaging our young thespians, and remembering all of those who have made TCT into the vital community asset it is today.

We are sure you will delight in our production of Elf The Musical JR. The children have worked hard to perfect their roles and we are proud of their efforts. Our second show will be Disney's The Little Mermaid JR April 29-May 1, 2022. An audition workshop will be held Feb. 27 at 2 pm with auditions March 3 and 4. We invited all children ages 5-18 to join us!

This is a very exciting time for TCT, not only getting back on stage, but working with the City of Tuscaloosa, the Nick's Kids Foundation, and the Children's Hands-On Museum to create the state-of-the-art Saban Center. TCT is thrilled to be part of this amazing project that will be a destination point for families and a jewel for our city.


