Each Day...



Please be mindful of these times, as beforecamp and after-camp care are not offered. Students should bring a packed drink and snack to camp each day. Campers will arrive at the normal time on Friday (8:00 am) with the showcase to begin at 11:00am. There is a possibility that the last day of camp will NOT be held at TCT, but at an alternate performance venue (see below).

Each Day...



Performances on Saturday, July 13 will occur at 10am and 12pm.

ABSENTEE POLICY

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Tuscaloosa Children's Theatre will follow the typical scheduling of the Tuscaloosa City School System along with any of the calls made by the Tuscaloosa City Board of Education regarding inclement weather. We will also email and post to our social media accounts regarding any closings. We do not refund for inclement weather closings.

DRESS CODE
