Education Scholarships And Conference Sponsorship

The Executive Committee of the Mass Chapter shall vote at the annual meeting to fund for four education scholarships for the early bird registration fee for Boston 2022 IAAO members. If awarded, the scholarships and sponsorship are to be used during the current calendar year. The successful applicant will be determined by a majority of the Executive Committee.

One course scholarship shall be awarded to a Chapter member towards an IAAO course, workshop or forum.

Applications are limited to one application by a candidate per calendar year. Priority is given to those who applied in a previous year and did not receive a scholarship. Preference is given to those who are seeking an IAAO designation or attending a national conference for the first time.

To qualify the applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Be an IAAO member in good standing
- Be a MASS Chapter member in good standing.
- Use the scholarship or sponsorship in the current calendar year
- Must show a financial need

Scholarships and Sponsorships are awarded without regard to race, sex or national origin of the applicant.
