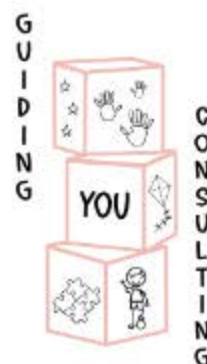


LUCY'S LOWDOWN
