

## **Bible Study Lesson Plan;**

### **“The New Testament is concealed in the Old Testament, and the Old Testament is revealed in the New Testament ” [Chuck Missler]**

A planned study of the Word of God based upon trying to understand what our Lord has intentioned for us by looking at the prophecy of the “end times,” through the teaching and examples given in the Holy Scriptures.

I propose to look at the New Testament, assuming a basic experience with the Old Testament, starting and ending with the Book of Revelation. Prophecy, it is said, is one-third of the bible; So, let’s look at Revelation as it relates to the whole Word of God.

I have purposefully made a chronological timeline (from an earthly point of view) because I have never heard anyone-else do it. I’m trying to cause you to think and question what I am saying and what you think you believe. I am not making a new doctrine, don’t be afraid to challenge it, but back up your challenge with scriptures. This will cause you to “study the scriptures daily to see if these things are so, like a Berean” (Act 17:11)

### The Apostle's Creed Study;

The basic statement of what we believe and why we believe it.

## **The Book of Revelation Study Guides, with commentary;**

### Abridged Revelation Theory Timeline;

Getting an idea of where we are going.

### Revelation Theory Timeline

Showing some of the Old Testament references used in Revelation to aid in understanding the illustrations of concepts used by John and rearranging the order of the events, around the numbered Seals, Trumpets and Bowls, into an earth-centric, chronological order; within the framework of the whole Word of God.

### 7 Letters to 7 Churches;

A closer look at, and expanded references for, the letters to the Churches of Asia that were dictated by Jesus.

### Comparing;

A look at the Parables of Jesus in Matthew 13:3>:52, the Epistles of Paul to 7 Churches, the 7 Letters to the Churches in Rev 2: and 3: and the characteristics of the Church during the Church Age.

### Rapture;

Verses on the Pre-Tribulation Rapture and highlighting the differences between the Appearing of Christ and the Return of The King.

Crowns:

Expectations, and the rewards, for the overcomers of the Church Age believers.

Salvation and the holy spirit;

The basic requirements for salvation, and the manifestations and the fruit of the gift of Holy Spirit

144,000;

More verses about the 144,000 of the Tribes of Israel that are Sealed with the Holy Spirit to protect them as a remnant through the Tribulation period.

Psalms 83:

Expansion of the view of what instigates the opening of the 6<sup>th</sup> Seal, the 7<sup>th</sup> Seal, and the 1<sup>st</sup> Trumpet, and which nations are involved.

Anti-Christ;

Traits and characteristics of the Son of Perdition, who was [instigated the attack on Israel] is not [was conspicuously killed in the attempt] and is about to rise from the bottomless pit, [is resurrected from the grave by Satan -5<sup>th</sup> Trumpet] and go to destruction [the Lake of Fire-Rev 20:]

The Abomination of Desolation;

The pivotal event in the Revelation Timeline:

Fulfilling the Feasts;

An article on how Jesus met the requirements celebrated by the Jewish Faith in their sacred Feasts Days.

Revelation XL Timeline;

Graphic representation of the basic timeline.

**Old Testament Book Studies with an eye on Revelation**

The Book of Genesis;

Everything that was started in Genesis is completed in Revelation.

Genesis Genealogy;

The Christian gospel is hidden in the 1st book of the Torah!

Joseph;

Joseph as a type of Christ, and, just for fun, a comparison of the traits of Joseph compared to the traits given for Imhotep of Egypt.

#### The Book of Ruth;

What the concept of the scroll in Rev 5:1> as a Title Deed might be, the role of the Kinsman Redeemer, and prototypes of Naomi in the role of Israel, Ruth as the Church, and Boaz as the Redeeming Christ figure.

#### Noahide Law;

The Covenant God made with Noah, and therefore all mankind, after the flood, related by commentary on an article, to the present times.

#### The Red Heifer;

A little known and mostly misunderstood (by Christians) Priestly Law of the Mosaic Temple worship and how it relates to the story of Jesus at the marriage in Cana- John2:1>.

#### The Book of Yoshua;

Yoshua is the Hebrew name of the Greek version Jesus. We read the Book of Joshua to see the foreshadowing of Christ in the Book of Revelation.

#### Hosea;

The Northern Kingdom of the House of Israel, closely resembles the apostasy and religious hypocrisy of our present times. We can learn from diagnosing their maladies and their judgement from God.

### **Easter Studies**

#### Reflections on Ash Wednesday;

Observation of the need for repentance.

#### The Season of Lent;

Observance of the trials of Christ, and our need to straighten our lives out to meet the desires of our God, Creator and Savior.

#### Differences in Lent;

An article about how Lutherans and Catholics celebrate Lent.

#### Was Easter Borrowed;

Did our sacred Holy-day originate with a pagan festival? (NO)

#### Easter in the light of the Passover;

The Hebrew origins of the Easter celebration.

Pentecost;

The birth of the Body of Christ. Jews and Gentiles empowered by the Holy Spirit to be victorious over the deceptions of the Adversary.

3 Words;

The words that describe our relationship with our Messiah, and explain the reason for our hope and joy.

## **New Testament Book Studies**

The Epistle to the Romans;

The first of a triune of Christian statement of doctrine based upon-  
Hab 2:4- The just shall live by faith.  
Paul asks “who are the justified?”  
The answer is: The loyal believing Jews and Gentiles.

The Epistle to the Ephesians;

The second book of Christian doctrine.  
Paul asks “How shall the just live?”  
The answer is: By the guidance and power of the Holy Spirit.

Praying in the Spirit;

Standing against principalities and powers that are opposition to God.

The Epistle to the Thessalonians;

The third book of Christian doctrine.  
  
Paul asks “What is the faith of the just?”  
The answer is: Belief in the resurrection unto eternal life by the “snatching away”  
from the wrath to come.

The 1<sup>st</sup> Epistle to the Corinthians;

A call to unity within the Church and an explanation of the workings of the Holy Spirit.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Epistle to the Corinthians;

Warnings of corruption of the doctrine of the Apostles and exhortation to stand strong together in the faith.

The Epistle to the Galatians;

The results of manifesting the spirit filled walk with Christ-in-you.

The Epistle to the Philippians;  
Rejoicing in the Lord.

The Epistle to the Colossians;  
Christ-in-you, the hope of glory.

### **The Pastoral Letters;**

Timothy;  
Hold to the faith and Apostolic doctrine.

Titus;  
Speak sound doctrine.

Philemon;  
Reconciliation exemplified through a personal case.

### **The Jewish centric letters;**

Hebrews;  
Jesus is better than the Angels, Moses, and the Temple Priests, and examples of living your faith in the Old Testament.

James;  
Be a doer of the word, not a hearer only.

Peter;  
Be Holy as Christ is Holy.

John;  
The joy of being a child of God.

Jude;  
Fight for the faith; and a look at religious apostasy and hypocrisy through Old Testament examples.

Psalms 91;  
A direct and explicate promise from God to save HIS people from the destruction of unbelief; even through plagues and pestilence.

The United States of America is an example for our understanding of God's plan also. (I am inclined to think God set it up that way)

The constitution is our guiding principles as Americans, just as the New Testament is our guiding principles as Christians.

As Americans we are called upon to voluntarily abide by the laws enumerated in the constitution:
