Salvation and the holy spirit

- Joh 20:31 But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.
- Joh 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Joh 3:14 And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up:
- Joh 3:15 That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life.
- Joh 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Joh 3:17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be <u>saved</u>.

The Gospel

- **1Co 15:1** Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;

- 1Co 15:3 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that <u>Christ died for our sins</u> according to the scriptures;

Salvation

Rom 10:9 That <u>if thou shalt confess</u> with thy mouth <u>the Lord Jesus</u>, <u>and shalt believe</u> in thine heart <u>that God hath raised him from the dead</u>, <u>thou shalt be saved</u>. [made whole - body/formed + soul/made + spirit/created]

Rom 10:10 For with the heart [soul] man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth [body] confession is made unto salvation.[spirit]

Justification – past – separation from the penalty of sin (redemption)

Sanctification – present – separation from the power of sin (righteousness)

Glorification – future – separation from the presence of sin (reward)

Holy spirit

Eph 1:13 In whom [Jesus] ye also *trusted*, after that [when] ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit [pneuma] of promise,

(Act 2:16 But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel 2:28>29)

Eph 1:14 Which is the earnest (guarantee) of our inheritance (salvation) until the redemption of the purchased possession, (us) unto the praise of his glory.

Joh 14:26 But the Comforter, the Holy Ghost [pneuma], whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

Act 1:4 And while staying with them he ordered them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father, which, he said, "you heard from me;

Act 1:5 for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."

1Co 12:7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man, to profit withall.

[for the advantage of the group, the Church, the Body]

[3 groups of manifestations, instructional, impartational, inspirational]

[instructional manifestations]

1Co 12:8 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom;

to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit;

[impartational manifestations]

1Co 12:9 To another faith by the same Spirit;

to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;

1Co 12:10 To another the working of miracles;

to another prophecy;

to another discerning of spirits;

[inspirational manifestations]

to another divers kinds of tongues;

to another the interpretation of tongues:)

1Co 12:11 But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing [giving] to every man severally [idios=his own, this is the only place this word is translated that way] as he will.

(to each person, what he wants, according to his willingness and need by discretion of the spirit)

Manifestations;

[Instructional manifestations]

The Word of Wisdom; Direction; The practical application of knowledge. Knowing what to do with knowledge.

The Word of Knowledge: Revelation of information.

[Impartation manifestations:]

Faith: Conviction that leaves no room for doubt of any kind. <u>Believing is a choice</u> that leads to faith; but faith is not a choice to be made, but a state of mind to be aspired to. Trust in God at the root level.

Gifts of Healing: Gift"s" because each healing is distinct and individual in nature, and directed to a specific person. When the Israelites, as a nation, ate the Passover meal, they, individually, were healed, and when Moses raised up the bronze serpent on the staff, in the wilderness, they were healed, as they, individually, looked upon it. Num. 8:21

Miracles: The ability to produce results that are beyond our normal scope of operation, large or small, also can be evidenced by the timing of an event.

Prophecy: Speaking for God; Foretelling (the future) or Forth telling (the present)

Discerning of Spirits: The realization of the underlying spiritual influence in persons and their actions, good or bad.

[Inspirational manifestations:]

Divers kind of Tongues: language, Speaking directly to/for God, bypassing our understanding; the prayers that God deems need to be said, or speaking words that are given from God, to you. To speak,

believing that God will understand, even if you don't. This is the only manifestation that is for the building up of the person using it, the rest are meant to be used in the service of others.

Interpretation of Tongues: Revelation of the message given from God.

Speaking in tongues/prophecy is not the least of the manifestations; It might be the greatest. In order to accomplish it you must draw on, all at the same time; Knowledge that it is called for; Wisdom of how to do it; Faith that it is possible, and that God will provide the words you need; Discerning of spirits to be sure that it is not counterfeit; It's a Miracle that you even **can** do it; and it's Healing to **your** soul and spirit, even if not to any- one else.

You are not required to use the power of the gift of holy spirit; but it is available if you choose to.

Joh_15:16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and *that* your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.

Joh_15:8 Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples.

Mat 7:20 Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.

Gal 5:22 But the <u>fruit of the Spirit</u> is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, [patience] gentleness, goodness, faith,

Gal 5:23 Meekness, [humility] temperance: [self-control] against such there is no law.

[this is the fulfillment of the law]

<u>Fruit of the Spirit:</u> The results in our life, of having received the Holy Spirit and working the manifestations

Love: Agapeo = God's love while walking with Christ Jesus as Lord; manifesting and receiving a high

regard for and from all persons [Love of the highest caliber]

Joy: To be lit up with light, encourages with effervescence [Love exulting]

Peace: End of the fight, untroubled, quietness [Love at ease]

Longsuffering: Long on love, patient, slow to anger, [Love enduring]

[Patience]

Gentleness: A soothing goodness manifested in kindness one to another, wins by encouraging [Patience passive]

Goodness: morality, living according to guidelines beyond self-gratification, a harmonious attraction, [Patience active]

Faith: trust, a choice made that has become ingrained to every aspect of life; conviction of a good outcome [Patience enduring]

Heb 11:6 Now without faith it is impossible to please God, for whoever comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who diligently search for him.

Meekness: <u>Humility</u>, <u>tenderness</u>, <u>free from haughty self-sufficiency</u> [Faith in God]

Temperance: Dominion of self, self-control, self-discipline [Faith in yourself]

The way your life reflects these attributes is the measurement and report of your relationship with God through Christ's redeeming grace.

Faith without actions, (that speak of your relationship to God) is of no use to anybody, especially God; but you will still be saved, and have to account for what you did, or did not, do with the gifts that He gave to you.

Jas 2:18 But someone will say, "You have faith and I have works." Show me your faith apart from your works, and I will show you my faith by my works.

Mic 6:8 He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?
