Rev 1:19 Write therefore the things that you have seen, [Glory of Christ] those that are [[Letters to the Churches](#)] and those that are to take place **after this**. [An outline of the structure of the book]

Rev 4:1 After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: ...
John gets a heavenly perspective of the Church Age [the first 6 Seals] and beyond...

Rev 7:1 After this I saw four angels standing at the four corners of the earth...
7th Seal-The Holy Spirit is restraining the "lawless one" while the 144,000 remnant are being sealed

Rev 7:9 After this I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, ...
The Church has been Raptured

Rev 9:12 One woe is past; [5th Trumpet] *and*, behold, there come two woes more hereafter. [after this]
[not in consecutive order, but a parenthetical warning of what's coming]

Woe #2 -6th Trumpet-The "Time of Jacob's Trouble" [judgement of the Jews first]
Woe #3-7th Trumpet- The "Battle of Armageddon" [then the judgement of the Gentiles]

Rev 15:5 And after that I looked, and, behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened:
The death of the 2 witnesses, and starting the judgement of Israel [6th Trumpet]

Rev 18:1 And after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power; ...
Babylon [Jerusalem] is fallen, is fallen.

Rev 19:1 And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; ...
"for he has judged the great prostitute who corrupted the earth with her immorality, [Jerusalem] and has avenged on her the blood of his servants"[Rev 19:2] Atonement has been made

[7th Trumpet and the 7 Bowl Judgements happens here]

Rev 20:3 ... and after that he must be loosed a little season.
Satan is released after the millennial reign until the White Throne Judgement. Rev 20:11>

Rev 21:3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God *is* with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, *and be* their God.

Rev 21:4 And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

Rev 21:5 And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful.
