Cleanup Activities This Week

- Completed survey of bottom of Van Dunk Lane excavation
- Completed placement of geotextile at Van Dunk Lane cul-de-sac near the Cannon Mine Pit (CMP)
- Completed backfill placement on Van Dunk Lane at the CMP
- Completed placement and leveling of Dense Graded Aggregate (DGA) on Van Dunk Lane for road subbase
- Completed pull back of additional waste material on west side of CMP
- Continued truck delivery of clean fill at CMP
- Continued placement and compaction of clean fill in CMP
- Began mobilization of equipment to the O'Connor Disposal Area (OCDA)
- Completed installation of temporary parking area at the OCDA
- Conducted Soil Erosion and Sediment Control (SESC) inspections for all areas
- Conducted air quality, vibration, and settlement monitoring

Cleanup Activities Next Week

- Continue waste material pull back at the CMP
- Continue clean fill truck deliveries at the CMP
- Begin installation of geotextile on the CMP outside of the Van Dunk Lane cul-de-sac
- Continue placement and compaction of clean fill in the CMP
- Complete mobilization of equipment to the OCDA to begin waste pull back
- Conduct SESC inspections for all areas
- Continue air quality, vibration, and settlement monitoring

Site Background

The 500-acre Ringwood Mines/Landfill site is in a historic iron mining district in the borough of Ringwood in Passaic County, New Jersey where car parts and paint sludge wastes were dumped on the ground and in abandoned mine pits.

EPA originally placed the site on the Superfund program's National Priorities List (NPL) in September 1983. The site was deleted from the NPL in 1994. EPA placed the site on the NPL in 2006 a second time after discovering more contamination. The selected cleanup action for the Peters Mine Pit Area, Cannon Mine Pit Area and the O'Connor Disposal Area is currently being constructed.
