

CENTURY HOUSE PLAQUE-RIDLEY PARK LANDMARK PROPERTY

Want a *Century House Plaque* but are confused about the verification process? Are you interested in finding out the basic history of your house? Well, it's a simple task that can be performed right at your computer. Delaware County has made the process painless through the access of their website.

Delaware County's Recorder of Deeds processes and preserves records relating to real property dating back to the year 1789, the year Delaware County was founded. Documents processed include Deeds, Mortgages, Satisfactions of Mortgage, Financial Statements, Veterans Discharge Papers, Notary Publics, Police Commissions, Highway Plans, Subdivision Plans, Powers of Attorney, Assignments of Mortgage, and Releases of Mortgage.

In January 1987, the Recorder of Deeds office converted to an on-line computer system with the Data Processing department. The new system provides the residents of Delaware County, title companies and attorneys an up-dated system of retrieving real estate data from January 1982 to date.

The *Century House* Plaque program recognizes Ridley Park homeowners and their 100 year-old house with a bronze plaque. The 6 inch by 6 inch



square bronze plaque is affixed to the property and identifies it as a "Ridley Park Landmark Property" and the year it was erected. The *Century House* plaque is available to Ridley Park Historical Society members \$250.00. Non-RPHS

members \$275.00.

If you've been considering adorning your home with a Century House plaque, now is the time. You can download an application form on our website www. ridleyparkhistorical.org. A member of the Ridley Park Historical Society will confirm the date the property was erected and order the plaque. The turnaround time is normally 6-8 weeks.
