This will become critical in a couple months, and we would like to have a smooth transition.

The second improvement is the intention to receive suggestions for our monthly programs. We have a strong and dedicated history of patriotic programs, which we will continue to feature. FROM THE DESK OF THE TREASURER



Brothers: Even more exciting news this year, With the advantage of the more aggressive investment portfolio we undertook two years ago we have increased our investment return income by \$12,000.00 over last year and deposited \$44,000.00 this year.

The Executive Board made the decision at the February Executive Board Meeting to retain \$16,000.00 of the \$44,000.00 in our operating account, and reinvest \$28,000.00 in the Valley of Fort Myers Savings Account.

With the increase of income we are now able to self-sustain and can continue to maintain our current yearly dues, and are taking advantage of the additional monies by reinvesting for the future of the Valley.

Brothers it is the aim of the leadership of the Valley to aggressively support and promote the investment program to attain financial stability to the Valley. Prior to 2010 the Valley had in excess of \$1.5M in the bank, (not including the Perpetual Fund). In 2017 the Valley had accumulated a deficit of \$36,000 in the operating account, We were forced to withdraw money from the Valley's Saving account and increased the yearly Due's to maintain a financial break-even operating point.

By building up our reserves, we will be able to update and replace our office equipment, kitchen equipment and utensils, lodge room and backstage props and costumes.

As a Valley we were able to assist 18 fellow Brother Masons in the aftermath of Hurricane lan with the Almoner's Fund, and also assisted some of the local Blue Lodges in our area. We would like to have been able to contribute more. As a Valley we will be able to provide additional financial assistance when needs dictate, without material injury to ourselves. Charity, is the foremost part of our Masonic Obligation.

We were notified by the Supreme Council that the Per Capita Tax will increase in 2024 by \$1.00 to \$31.00, and then 2025 through 2028 raised by \$1.00 per year until the Per Capita Tax will be reach \$35.00 in 2028.

To our Perpetual and Life Members: Once again, the Executive Board will be reaching out to you, our Perpetual and Life Members of the Valley, to voluntary donate toward the Per Capita Taxes. For those who have donated over the years we thank you and look forward to your continued loyalty and support.

Hello my Brothers and Knights,


The Knight Commander of the Court of Honour (KCCH) brothers have continued to meet regularly prior to Consistory. We are working on restarting some of our fun events that

We achieved a fantastic 4th year of meeting and exceeding our goal of \$15,000. This is quite an accomplishment for you who have so generously donated to our number one charity: The Johns Hopkins All Children's Clinic.

The Executive Board and me as the Representative/Trustee of the S. R. Foundation Valley of Fort Myers, thank all of you with gratitude and a major amount of humility, for what you have done to accomplish this feat. It has taken a great team effort to achieve what we have succeeded in doing these last 4 years.

While visiting the Johns Hopkins Clinic at Cleveland and Winkler, I asked the Director how most of the Children and their families fared out with Hurricane Ian. She informed me that more than 25% of the patients and families had experienced total losses of their possessions (and) house and home. In the past few months, we have seen many examples of "CHARITY" through the giving of others in the craft and community. Monetarily and physically. With "FAITH ", HOPE" and "CHARITY" the possibilities are endless to help bring us back to normalcy for those who suffered these tremendous Losses. Let us be reminded, even though some of us were not affected to the point that we lost everything, a lot of other people have suffered great losses. However, some of us can afford to give a little more than others. We "humbly" ask for you to give what you can afford to give and to be as generous as you can. At this point in the fiscal year of 2022-23 we are at about midway to our Goal of \$15,000. We are at 55% and we need 45% or better in the next few months to reach our goal.


