

GENERAL SECRETARY

FROM THE DESK OF THE TREASURER



Brothers: 2023 has not been very profitable. Our portfolio has been slowly decreasing in value since the end 2021. To date our holdings are down 19%. Fortunately since 2021 when the Executive Board approved the reallocation of our portfolio we are still accumulating cash on our investments. As of the August 2023 the Valley has accumulated \$20,560.00 so far this year.

The Executive Board is reviewing our ability to generate income and reduce expenditure. First and foremost this is mostly dependent on the recruitment of new Brothers into the Scottish Rite. Over the last four Reunions

we have averaged 10 to 12 new members. If any Brother has any suggestion on this subject please forward them to a member of the Executive Board for consideration.

As mentioned in our previous newsletter, we will be raising the Per Capita Tax in line with the Supreme Councils increases, set out as follows, 2024 by \$1.00 to \$31.00, then 2025 through 2028 raised by \$1.00 per year until the Per Capita Tax will be reach \$35.00 in 2028.

To our Perpetual and Life Members: Once again, the Executive Board will be reaching out to you our Perpetual and Life Members of the Valley to voluntarily donate toward the Per Capita Taxes. For those who have donated over the years we thank you and look forward to your continued loyalty and support.

There has been a change in the times scheduled for the January 11th, 2024 "FOR THE CHILDREN" dinner event. We have added the time of 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. to allow this time for a special presentation for the children and families in attendance. The dinner hour and main event will remain the same, 6:00 p.m. and continue until 9:00 p.m.

Bro. John Troia and I have done many of these presentations and they are quite unique and enjoyed by all who attend.

The Naples Base Chapter of The United States Submarine Veterans, Inc. (USSVI) has agreed to display their 25 ft, long parade float during this event. This is a replica of the USS Florida SSGN-728. It was built to honor Submarine Sailors lost at sea during WWII.

There will be a special USSVI presentation honoring several of the children of the Johns Hopkins Clinic by honoring them as Honorary Submariners. This presentation will begin at 17:00 hours and end at 18:00 hours (5:00 p.m.-6:00 p.m.). There will be no need for a ticket for this presentation; it will be open to the public. However, to attend the main event, a ticket is required.

Dinner will begin at 6:00 p.m. and last until all have been served. Introduction of VIPs, administrators of Johns Hopkins and speakers will begin at approximately 7:30 p.m. and conclude with Keynote speaker, Illustrious James D. Cole, 33° Sovereign Grand Commander of the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite.

We are very sincere in our reporting to you that this event is going to be very exciting and is a one of a kind ever in Southwest Florida.
