RE: 6 MONTH REPORT

Brethren, I am proud to report to you, as your Representative/ Trustee of the Scottish Rite Foundation of Florida, the progress of this year's ongoing donations for our number one charity, the

Johns Hopkins All Children's Clinics here in Florida. At the end of January we have accomplished a rather pleasing 50.05% of the goal set for us of \$18,900 for the 2019-2020 year. At the time of this writing, this amounts to approximately \$9,544, which to me is fantastic! I, along with the Executive Board, thank each one of you for your generous donations so far this year. It's rewarding to know that we are currently ahead of our goal of last year by 25%. However, we only have five months to achieve our goal of 100% and reach the \$18,900 which has been rather difficult for us to obtain in the past. Given the fact that, last year, we only had 118 brethren donate to our cause and very few other donors, we must reach deeper into our pockets to come up with the remainder of our goal which is approximately \$9,366.

With the knowledge of only having 118 brethren who are willing or able to contribute, I would like to propose a way that we may achieve our goal. Let's say we can get 125 (out of 625) to commit to contribute \$75 over the next five months. If we just commit to contribute a minimum pledge of only \$15 each month for five months, it will put us right where we need to be. We need our perpetual members to help contribute a little more than you have in the past. I will commit to this contribution! Will you? Sure, you will. Why not?

We now have the bulletin board up with the Double Eagle Award points displayed (plus the bonus points) for all to see just where you are in the standings to become a member of the "Billionaire Club." I'm excited about some of you getting extra bars to attach to your Double Eagle Medallion, get a lapel pin with a stone and your name plate for the wall plaque. The wall plaque will arrive shortly and it would please the Executive Board to see all our brethren with their names on the beautiful wall plaque for all to see. Please, if you have any questions about the Double Eagle awards or questions about the "bonus points," feel free to ask me or Brother Bob Zimmerman.
