Although the Secretary's work load eased up a bit, I can assure you that all the paperwork, updates on all our Scottish Rite Brothers, transfers in the membership portal, phone calls, and personal visits (if possible) continued.

So, as you know, the Spring Reunion was suspended (thank you, China). All the candidates from then will be available for the Fall Reunion on October 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>. ## SCOTTISH RITE FOUNDATION REPRESENTATIVE



Thomas Paine on December 19, 1776 wrote" The American Crisis" which appeared for the first time in th Pennsylvania Journal:

"These are the times that try men's souls; the summer soldier and the sunshine patriot will, in this crisis, shrink from the service of his country; but he that stands it now, deserves the love and thanks of man and woman. Tyranny, like hell, is not easily conquered; yet we have this consolation with us, that the harder the conflict, the more glorious the triumph."

At that time, Brother George Washington had his troops encamped along the Delaware River opposite Trenton, New Jersey. Washington had faced a series of humiliating defeats; He lost New York City to the British, had accomplished little except retreat, and approximately 11,000 of his troops had quit and gone home to their families. Contracts for his remaining troops were expiring the end of December. He was aware without some victory to grasp on to and improve morale, all would be soon lost. His famous raid on December 25, 1776 across the Delaware is well known and the surprise attack on the Hessian troops provided the rallying cry and needed morale to keep his fledgling army, and our revolutionary values, in the fight.

We see New York under siege again and the entire country and world is facing uncertainty, trepidation, and angst as we face this unseen foe in the form of the Corvid virus. If there was ever a time to see the value of what our Brotherhood is - maybe it is now. The commitment to **Truth**, **Honor**, **Virtue**, **Charity**, and **Brotherly Love** made manifest in our vows cement a security and solid belief and certainty that each of us is there for each other, our families, and our communities. We all are experiencing our own personal challenges during these times and handling them to the best of our abilities. Some will face severe hardship, others may be much luckier, but all of us have had our lifestyles, livelihoods, and Masonic lives affected adversely to a greater or lesser degree. May we all recognize the value of each other and the strength we gain communally as the great Brotherhood we are as we reach out from our places of sequestration. We will persevere.

While we keep our priorities straight and make sure we take care of ourselves, families, those we love, and Brethren during this time, please remember as well some of our ongoing responsibilities that we as Scottish Rite Masons have assumed. We are looked upon to provide support for the Scottish Rite Foundation. Our plaque is proudly displayed on the Ft. Myers Clinic, part of the Johns Hopkin's Network of All Children's Specialty Care that we have committed to support. Currently we stand at about 65% of our annual goal of \$18,900. We need to raise \$ 6,615 by the end of June to meet this challenging goal.

For those of us who have been donating \$10 for a bi-weekly dinner at our lodge meetings, could consider these donations as contributions for the Foundation for the months May and June. It would be of great help toward our goal. If one has been having dinner at least twice a month at a blue lodge and one SR dinner, that would be \$60 for two months. Combine this \$60 with 8.3% of a stimulus check of \$1,200 (roughly \$100) that would be \$160 for the two months. For all who help by contributing \$100 or more from the first of May through all of June, ending June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020, I will give another 100 Double Eagle bonus points.

If you find yourself with the means during these trying times, please consider making a donation today. We as an organization have assumed this responsibility. Every contribution will benefit **"Helping Children Communicate"**.

To all our friends and Brothers, be safe, be courageous, be charitable. Remember our obligation for the children.
