FROM THE TREASURER



Brothers: Exciting news this year. The Executive Board decided to take advantage of an opportunity offered us by the SGIG of Florida III. Rick Hoover last year. We took full advantage of more aggressive investment vehicles. The results of the new investments returned to the Valley just over \$32,000 as compared to last year's return of just over \$12,000.

We decided to retain \$25,000 in our operating account, and reinvest \$7,000 in the Valley of Fort Myers savings account. With this increased deposit we are now self-sustaining and taking advantage of investing for the future of the Valley.

Now the big "IF"... If the Stock Market maintains this current trend we are anticipating an annual return this year (2022) of over \$40,000 which will relieve the financial pressure on the Valley.

To our Perpetual and Life Members: Once again, the Executive Board will be reaching out to you our Perpetual and Life Members of the Valley to voluntary donate toward the Per Capita Taxes. For those who have donated over the years we thank you and look forward to your continued loyalty and support.


