

FROM THE GENERAL SECRETARY'S DESK

The spring reunion was a success. Being held in Tampa, 13 candidates were recipients of the Royal Secret. Hopefully everyone knows Illustrious Augie Luce; he has received the highest honor from the Grand Lodge of New Jersey, the Daniel Coxe Medal. Brother Kurt Wagner will present to Augie at his house on behalf of the Grand Master of New Jersey. Augie mentored many of the Grand Staff and was very active in the Scottish Rite. He was Chaplain of Tropical Lodge for quite sometime. A brief story about Augie: He was a buck sergeant in the 35th infantry division. He landed in Normandy on D-Day. He fought in the breakout at St. Lo and then across France with the 3rd Army under General Patton. On December 17th, 1944 Augie was part one of the greatest redeployments in military history. The 3rd division disengaged, pivoted 90 degrees and raced North to relieve the 101st Airborne Division in Bastogne. While advancing toward the village on Christmas Eve he was wounded. His fighting days were over and he returned to the United States. Augie was a pretty good marksman and won many a turkey shoot after the war (this information was provided by M:W: Robert V. Moncelli, Grand Master of Masons of New Jersey). Ill. Augie will be 99 in December.

The Guest Speaker for the Consistory in May was Brother David Ray, retired FBI agent. The speaker for June will be III. Chuck Morgan from Baton Rouge, LA. He will be speaking about a submarine that was used in the Civil War. This should also prove to be very interesting. Who was Saint Andrew?

Saint Andrew was the first apostle chosen by Jesus and happens to be the patron Saint of Scotland. Saint Andrew has been celebrated in Scotland for over a thousand years, with feasts being held in his honor as far back as the year 1000 AD. However, it wasn't until 1320, when Scotland's independence was declared with the signing of The Declaration of Arbroath, that he officially became Scotland's patron saint.
