Tournament Rule and Regulations

All contestants must submit and pass a psychological stress evaluation test when requested ENTRY FEE is \$400.00 per club. A late fee of \$60.00 will be assessed after April 1, 2025.

Only clubs that are affiliated and in good standing with the Southern Bass Club Association is eligible to compete.

All fish must be taken with rod and reel on artificial lures, trolling will not be permitted.

All Local, state and federal laws must be obeyed.

Each club will fish with its own members (8) four boats per club, (2) men to each boat.

Each Team is to appoint a captain to be their spokesman. TEAM CAPTAIN MUST check with Tournament Committee between 5:30 P.M. and 7:30 P.M. on Thursday, MAY 1st, 2025. The Committee will be at the pavilion at Cypress Bend. (Meal Provided)

Any culling must be done prior to entering the Park

Only 12 bass per team per day, measuring (14) inches or more. Mouth must be closed and tail touching. A Golden Rule is the official measuring board.

Spotted bass are allowed and must measure a minimum of 12 inches.

DEAD fish will incur a 1-pound penalty.

NO COURTESY MEASUREMENTS AT SCALES.

The Tournament will begin at 6:30 A.M. unless otherwise stated at time of check in or at the end of the first day's weigh in as determined by the tournament committee. There will be only one line for weigh in on both days. Weigh in 4:00 p.m. both Friday and Saturday. Check in means you are in the line to weigh fish and must go to the scales.

There will be check in at the gate and at the marina. No grace period will be allowed.

No contestant is allowed to fish within 50 Yards of a competing boat that is tied or anchored unless permission has been granted.

All boats must have operating running lights and an operating kill switch that is attached to the driver's life jacket.

All contestants must wear Coast Guard approved life vests when the big engine is running.

Alcoholic beverages or narcotic drugs will not be allowed in boats during tournament hours, unless prescribed by a doctor.

Only "Elite 8" contestants are allowed on the lake for bass fishing. Other club members are allowed on the lake during tournament hours for any purpose other than bass fishing.

The lake will be off limits from 4:00P.M. Thursday until safe blast off on Friday, then again from 4:00 p.m. Friday until safe blast off on Saturday.

NO WAKE ZONE There positively will be no boats plowing wakes in marina area. No wake area will be marked.

Interpretation and enforcement of all rules will be the sole responsibility of the Tournament Committee. Any situation not covered by the above rules and regulations will be determined by the Tournament Committee and their decision will be final. Any protest must be made in writing within fifteen (15) minutes of the last weigh-in of that day.

If a club has more than one team, teams must cull a minimum of 100 yards apart.
