Frequently Asked Questions Winter 2023 Club Officer Training

Winter 2023 TLI - Frequently Asked Questions

How do I attend the TLI?

All TLIs for Winter 2023 will be held virtually. We will use Zoom as the virtual platform for attending. You can register on the <u>D54 website</u> under Events > TLIs. Session access and login details will be provided after participants register.

Will there be any in-person TLIs?

No. Unfortunately, we were unable to secure a venue to accommodate an in-person session. We understand this is disappointing and sincerely hope to offer in person options for the summer TLIs.

How do I earn credit for attending club officer training?

To earn training credit, club officers must:

- 1. Attend the full TLI. Each TLI is ~3.5 hours. Plan to attend all sessions of the TLI.
- 2. Complete the training survey.

As a reminder, at least four club officers need to attend this second-round club officer training to earn credit in the Distinguished Club Program (DCP).

Don't forget about the "Magnificent Seven" incentive for having all 7 club officer trained!

I serve in multiple officer roles for my club. How do I receive credit for each role?

Attend the session for your *highest ranked* officer role being served. As long as you attend the <u>full</u> TLI (~3.5 hours) and complete the training survey, you will receive training credit for all officer roles in which you serve. For example:

- If you serve as a Vice President and a Treasurer, attend the Vice President officer breakout discussion.
- If you serve as Secretary and Sergeant at Arms, attend the Secretary officer breakout session.

I serve as an officer for multiple clubs. How do I receive credit for each club?

Attend the session for your *highest ranked* officer role being served. As long as you attend the full TLI (~3.5 hours) and complete the training survey, you will receive training credit for all clubs in which you serve. For example:

- If you serve as a Vice President for club A, and a Treasurer for club B, attend the Vice President officer breakout discussion.
- Note: the scenario-based breakout sessions will include representation from multiple officer roles. Your insights from multiple officer roles will be a valuable part of those discussions.
- Don't forget about the "Pedal to the Medal" club <u>incentive</u> for attaining Distinguished status or better.

 Officer training is one of those DCP goals.

Is there a cost to attend the TLI?

No. There is no cost to attend the virtual TLIs in 2023.

What are the TLI dates and times?

There are three options available for TLIs. You are encouraged to attend the one (1) option that best fits your schedule:

Do all officers need to attend the same TLI option?

We encourage officers from the same club to attend the same training date, but it is not required.

What if I can't attend the full TLI?

Serving as a club officer involves a commitment to attending bi-annual TLIs. Club officers must attend one (1) <u>full</u> TLI and complete the training survey to receive training credit. Each TLI is ~3.5 hours. Choose an option that best fits your schedule.

What if I can't attend during any of the available dates?

You may be able to attend a TLI in another district. Please contact your Program Quality Director at blase heather m@cat.com for more information.

What is the deadline for club officers to attend training?

All club officers training must be complete training via a TLI no later than February 28.
