A Demo team has been formed for the Pekin Federal Correctional Institution (Pekin FCI) new club demonstration meeting in late January or early February. Security clearance forms have been gathered for submission in the next few days. It is expected to take about 2 weeks for security clearances to be completed. After that, the demo meeting date and time will be established. At least 50 inmates are expected to attend the demo meeting. Membership application forms will be passed out at that meeting. The educational coordinators at Pekin FCI will select the 25 members based on inmate behavior, history, and potential. If there is sufficient interest, it is possible that a second club could be formed after the first club is up and running.
