Initial discussions related to forming a new Toastmasters club at the Pekin Federal Correctional Institution were held on Thursday, 12 December with Pekin FCI educational staff members. Following those discussions, the staff received approval from their management team to proceed with forming a new Toastmasters club in the men's medium security side. A demo meeting is being planned for late January or early February depending on how soon security clearances for the demo team can be obtained. The demo meeting will be held in the "visitor's center" rather than the main cell block area of the facility. At least 50 inmates are expected to attend the demo meeting. D54 Toastmasters working toward their DTM can earn credit toward their DTM by serving as one of the new club sponsors or new club mentors. Please contact Jon R.
