Club Extension Report

D54 has a base of 50 clubs, and we currently have 48 paid clubs, up 1 club from last month. 50 clubs are necessary for our district to be distinguished, 51 clubs to be select distinguished, 52 clubs to be Presidents Distinguished, and 53 to be Smedley Distinguished. According to TI, D54 needs to have 60 paid clubs by June 30, 2024, to maintain our independent district status.

D54 has a new club chartered a new club in Elizabeth, Illinois at Jo Carroll Energy.

D54 Storytelling club is making progress toward going live. We have 4 volunteers and need only 3 more experienced Toastmasters to volunteer to attend 3 launch meetings to get started. Please contact Wendy Pesavento to volunteer. Patrick, CeCe, Estelle, and Bonnie have agreed to help. We only need 3 more volunteers.

Gary is working on a Spanish language club. He hopes to charter the club this TI year.

D54 received 1 lead this month from TI.

Club Retention Report - Tom Willison, DTM, PDG

D54 has a payment base of 1557 payments and has 890 member payments to date. D54 needs 1573 member payments to be Distinguished, 1604 to be Select Distinguished, 1635 to be Presidents Distinguished, and 1682 to be Smedley Distinguished. We have 9 clubs at charter strength or above. 19 clubs that fall into the 13-19-member range. We have 17 clubs that have 8-12 members. We have 5 club with 0-7 members. Our goal is to help every club earn DCP goal 7 (four new members) and goal 8 (four more new members).

D54 is ramping up our efforts to make 80 cold calls in the next month. So far this month we have made 12 with one response.

Prison Club Report – Jon Greiner, DTM

Jon's team is responsible for building new prison clubs and maintain current prison clubs, in District 54. New prison clubs are stalled due to a shortage of on-site volunteers.
