**I** = Initiative - As a Toastmasters Club, it is important that you take control of your meetings, own your efforts and move ahead - in the right direction. It is also important that you push your members to take ownership of their roles.

**N** = **Nudge** - As leaders, it's important to **nudge** prospective members into joining as well as current members to actively participate in meetings and contests, volunteer for club and district leadership roles, etc. Many members need a push in the right direction to provide needed encouragement.
