# **First-Half Key Accomplishments**

- Successful Transition to Virtual: Monthly DEC meetings, Summer TLIs, Hall of Fame Awards Ceremony, DTM Awards Ceremony, Monthly Area/Division Directors Training, Monthly Webinars, Committee Meetings, Club Meetings
- 21 of 21 (100%) Area/Division Directors Trained, 65 of 67 (97%) Club Visit Reports Submitted, 16 of 21 (76%) Area/Division Success Plans Completed
- 20+ Club Success Plans have been completed and submitted to the district

- Pathways Adoption: All Members: 84% (2<sup>nd</sup> of 10 clubs in Region 5). Officers: 94% (tied for 1<sup>st</sup> with another district in R5)

# **First-Half Challenges and Struggles**

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- COVID-19, Work From Home, Virtual Vs. In-Person Experience
- Paid Clubs: 56 of 67 clubs in base, -16.4% growth. 69 (1.03 \* Club Base) is needed to become distinguished
  - Last year same time: 70 of 76 clubs were paid (-7.9% growth)
- Member Payments/Retention: 814 (726 renewals + 88 new). 2,265 payments needed (1,451 more) to become distinguished through October and April renewals + new members.
  - Last year same time: 1,142 Payments (943 renewals + 199 new members)
- Moments of Truth: Only 1 club has completed? Google Form for handout / survey? Incentive deadline extended to January 31
- Pathways Adoption: New Members: 52.5% (below the region 5 average of 54.4%)


# **Second-Half Goals and Priorities**

- Encourage clubs to participate in district incentives (see d54tm.com/incentives)
- Support Pathways adoption and level completions; make sure all members who renewed membership in October or later choose a free path by December 31
- Successful and well attended Second round of officers training Leadership: Thrive in Change
- Well run and well attended speech contests and annual conference
- Effective marketing/advertising campaigns

### **Toastmasters International Updates and Due Dates**

- Free Pathways path: all members renewing membership before December 31, 2020, can choose a free path.
- New clubs: for any club chartering in November, December, or January, the charter fee (\$125.00) and new member fee (\$20.00 per member) will be waived. This can save \$525.00
- **Speakathons:** as per the email sent by TI on August 25 to all club presidents and VPEs, clubs can hold Speakathons where members come together and solely focus on giving speeches to progress on their path
- Online Speech Contest Guidelines: All contests must be held online. The contests may also be pre-recorded with all contestants and contest officials in physically distant locations and the recording to be shared at a later time with the audience.



#### **Toastmasters International Updates**

- Temporary exceptions to District Finance protocol: can budget expenses to exceed current year revenue
- **District Administrative Bylaws and Protocol 9.0:** changes related to district leaders election requirements
- Online Clubs Alignment Process: any new online club organized in the 2020-2021 program year may be aligned to a District of the club's choice with the district council approval. Clubs organized prior to July 1, 2020 (typically clubs in District U, Division O) can do the same.
- Club suspension and reimbursement
  - Clubs that have not yet met the April 2020 renewal requirement will have an additional six (6) months to return to good standing before being suspended.
  - The reinstatement fee has been reduced to \$100 USD (usually as high as \$720 USD for clubs that reinstated after two periods of inactivity).
  - Clubs are considered paid and in good standing when 8 payments are made 3 don't have to be renewing
