## **District 54 Prison Clubs Team: Update on Needs**

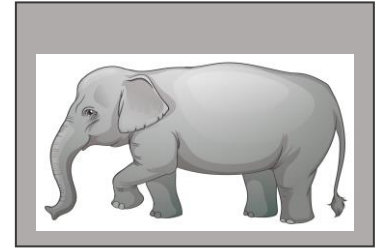

## The Elephant in the Room

This catch phrase is often used to draw attention to the obvious.

One of my biggest conundrums with Toastmasters, is club membership levels. Sometimes, and often more than not, membership is the ***elephant in the room***, standing in the way of a club being successful.

My contention is that club members' satisfaction, and Distinguished Club Program goal achieved go hand in hand. If the club members are happy, getting what they want from their Toastmasters experience, I contend they will stay involved. Involvement means, first of all, showing up at meetings, being the Toastmaster, giving prepared speeches, participating in Table Topics, giving Evaluations, volunteering to be Timer, and welcoming guests. My observation is, the more members present, and more individuals participating in a meeting, the happier and more successful the club will be.

One of the main reasons I volunteered and accepted the leadership position of Public Relations Manager for District 54 is to address the issue of membership goals. Here are a few of my thoughts on how to address our membership conundrum.

- **Involvement** – not just yours, but convince other members to be involved as well.

Examples:

- Sending out meeting notice and reminders
- Have meeting role signup sheets
- Personally ask members to take on roles
- Set an example, be involved yourself

- **Conduct quality meetings** – follow The Moments of Truth standards, work on making meetings better, pay attention to details

Examples:

- Read the Toastmasters Mission statement
- Start and end meetings on time
- Recognize member achievements at meetings

- **Advertise, Advertise, Advertise** – to recruit new members, use what works for your audience

Examples:

- Social Media – Facebook, Linked In, Twitter, Snapchat
- Meetup, Eventbrite, Mailchimp,
- Local publications & media outlets
- Local networking events

As Public Relations Manager, I ask all of us to embrace this elephant in the room. Fear it not. Let's grab arms and go shoulder to shoulder forward to face it together. We will succeed if we unite as involved and committed District 54 Toastmasters.

### Toastmasters District Leaders Mid-Year Training

Every year in January, Toastmasters International offers mid-year training to the top three leaders in each district. Mid-Year training for D54 leaders was held in New Orleans, LA, on January 17-18, 2020. I attended training with fellow District 54 leaders, Chris Boyk, District Director, and Andrea Gluck, Club Growth Director. It was a great opportunity to learn with peers, network, share best practices, create plans, brainstorm ideas, evaluate goals, and overcome barriers. Training included Team Communication, Active Listening, Role Breakout Sessions, Candid Conversations, Organization Updates, District Finance, and Transitioning for Success. The purpose of the Team Communication and Active Listening sessions and something we learned in those sessions are given below.

### Team Communication Strategies and Best Practices

#### Before Communication

- Know your objectives and outcomes, and make sure they are measurable
- Choose the right method to communicate your objectives prior to the conversation

#### At the Beginning of Communication

- State your objective and expected outcomes, and get buy-in

#### At the End of Communication

- Confirm all outcomes were accomplished and objective reached
- Review decisions made
- Summarize action items with timelines and confirm ownership

#### After Communication

- Send out notes on decisions made and action items with timelines and ownership
- Show appreciation
- Set a schedule for addressing open items
- Follow up with action item owners

**Active Listening Purpose:** Explore difficulties with active listening and improve active listening skills, resulting in better communication within teams

<b>Difficulty with Active Listening</b>	<b>Solution</b>
Thinking three to four times faster than people speak	While listening, identify speaker's key points. Restate the key points in sincere way; then confirm understanding.
Listening with the intent to respond rather than to understand	Use questions to clarify point and confirm understanding. Summarize main points to show listening. You don't have to agree with them or insist you are right. Set aside judgment and criticism. Ask if there is anything else you should know about the situation before adding your point of view. Use a phrase like "Something else to consider is..."
Giving advice	Before trying to solve their problem, ask questions. Ask "What have you considered in this situation?" "What have you tried to do to solve this?" "Tell me more about that."
Language Barriers	Speak slowly and clearly. State your point in a different way, using different words. Use visual methods of communication. Ask for feedback such as "Do you have any questions? Did I include everything that you need to know?" Use plain language, avoid words that aren't commonly used.



## What is Communication? By Chris Boyk, District 54 Director

What is the first thing that comes to mind when you hear the word, **Communication**?

Communication was a theme that kept coming up during the most recent Toastmasters District Leader Mid-Year Training. We heard interesting statistics about communication. Did you know that approximately 80% of all guests hear about Toastmasters clubs through the **Find a Club** section on the Toastmasters International website? Of those 500k+ guests globally, 63% of them are never contacted. *Yikes!* Of the guests who contact the club, 35% of them, globally, receive an undeliverable message from the club contact. *Double Yikes!*

As a member and leader, your communication is vital. If your message is not received, or if it is too vague, most likely nothing happens. District 54 – your district – is challenged with this. Do your members and leaders know what is happening at the district level?
